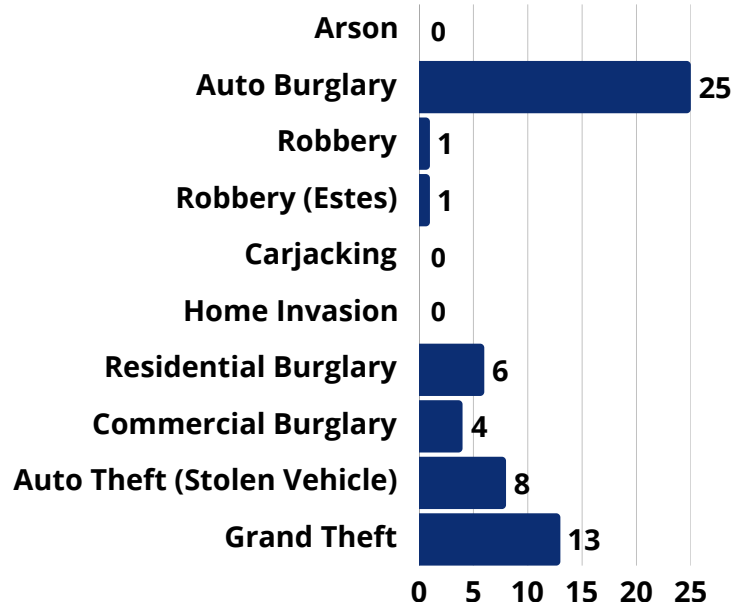

Battery/Auto Burglary

On 1/18, officers responded to an auto burglary at a park on Curtis St. The victim encountered a subject breaking into the victim's vehicle. When the victim interrupted the burglary, the subject battered him and fled in a vehicle. Using the vehicle's description and registration information, officers identified the subject. The case will be submitted for charging. #260118005

Drunk in Public

On 1/19, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment complex on Stevenson Blvd. The reporting party advised that a subject was changing clothes and attempting to convince juveniles to go with him. Upon contact, the subject showed signs of intoxication and was placed under arrest. #260119052

DUI

On 1/16, officers responded to a solo vehicle collision near Paseo Padre Pkwy and Sequoia Rd. A driver struck a curb and crashed into a tree. Upon contact, the subject showed signs of intoxication and was placed under arrest. #260116019

Injury Collision

On 1/17, officers responded to a solo vehicle injury collision on Niles Canyon Rd and Palomares Rd. A driver lost control of the vehicle, and the vehicle was on its side when officers arrived. Officers provided assistance to the driver and passengers and conducted traffic control in the area. #260117015

Outside Assist

On 1/18, officers responded to a residence on Seneca Park Loop that had caught fire the night before. The residence had been red-tagged, and contractors were on scene to board it up when multiple subjects attempted to enter. Contractors denied them entry, but one subject ran to the backyard shed to gather items, then ran out and fled in a vehicle. A search of the shed revealed ketamine, drug paraphernalia, and evidence of drug sales. This case remains under investigation. #260118014

Petty Theft

On 1/13, officers responded to a report of theft from a vehicle on Nicolet Ave. The victim encountered three subjects going through the vehicle's truck bed. Upon seeing the victim, the subjects fled in a vehicle. Loss was a jackhammer from a toolbox in the truck bed. #260113001

Shots Fired

On 1/14, officers responded to a report of a shooting near an apartment complex on Halogen Common. The reporting party heard three gunshots near his unit. Surveillance footage showed a driver pointing a semi-automatic handgun out of the window and firing three shots into the air. Three expended shell casings were found in the roadway in the area. No damage or victims of the shooting were located. This case remains under investigation. #260114001

Sideshow Activity

On 1/16, officers responded to multiple reports of sideshow activity near a sports club on Landing Pkwy. A large group of vehicles occupied the parking lot and intersection at W Warren Ave and Landing Pkwy. Officers prompted the group to leave the city, but they returned shortly after, taking control of the intersection at Alvarado Blvd and Deep Creek Rd. The officers successfully dispersed the group within approximately two hours, without incident. #P26005586

Vandalism

On 1/18, officers responded to a report of vandalism on Alder Ave. Video surveillance footage showed a subject attempting to unlock the victim's vehicle. Employees at a nearby food stand confronted the subject, who walked away before officers arrived. The subject was located and found to have an outstanding felony warrant. The subject was placed under arrest. #260119050
