### **Updates to January 27, 2026 Traffic Collision**

On January 27, 2026, at approximately 01:49 a.m., Fremont Police Officers responded to a report of a traffic collision at the intersection of Auto Mall Parkway and Cushing Parkway, involving a BMW M4 2-door coupe and a semi-truck with a trailer attached. FPD officers, Fremont Fire personnel, and paramedics arrived and began medical aid to the involved parties. The driver and a passenger of the BMW were both transported to a local hospital. The BMW driver received medical treatment and was later released from the hospital. The driver of the semi-truck was not injured and remained at the scene, fully cooperating with the investigation.

Fremont Police was notified by the hospital today that the passenger of the BMW, a 19-year-old adult male from San Jose, succumbed to his injuries at the hospital on Saturday, January 31, 2026.

The Fremont Police Traffic Unit assumed the collision investigation. The preliminary investigation indicates that the BMW was traveling northbound on Cushing Parkway, approaching the intersection of Auto Mall Parkway, with the decedent seated in the front passenger seat. The semi-truck was traveling westbound on Auto Mall Parkway, approaching the intersection of Cushing Parkway. Both vehicles entered the intersection and collided. The front of the BMW made impact with the middle of the trailer and was pulled underneath the trailer. The intersection is controlled by traffic signals, which were functioning properly at the time of the collision. The cause of the collision is still under investigation; however, drug or alcohol impairment is not suspected to be a contributing factor.

This is Fremont's third fatal traffic collision in 2026.
