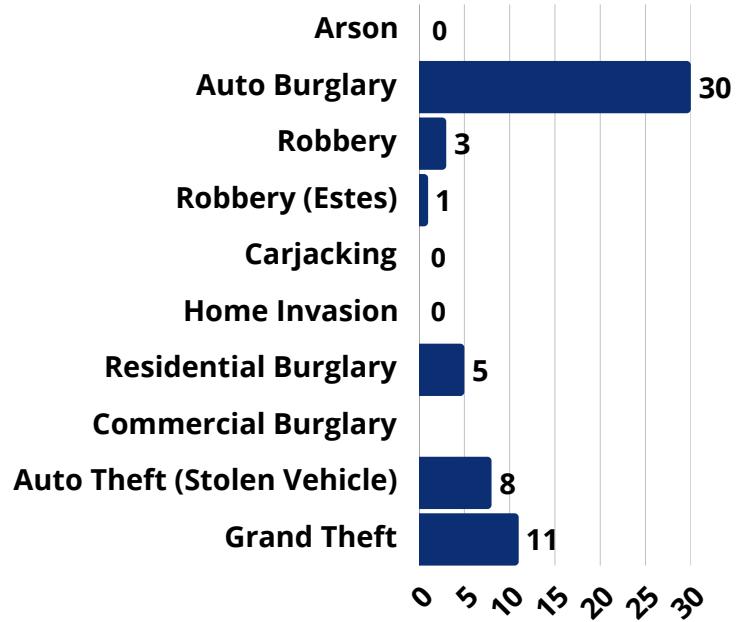

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 2/2, officers responded to a report of assault with a deadly weapon at a residence on Tan Oak Dr. The victim's son (subject) used a metal pole to break in through a glass door of the second-story balcony. The subject then struck the victims' vehicle with the pole, and the two victims fled in the vehicle. The subject stole the victims' other vehicle, but was located at a nearby apartment complex. The subject was placed under arrest. #260202039

Auto Burglary

On 1/29, officers responded to multiple auto burglaries on Plumleigh Dr. The reporting party witnessed five subjects looking into vehicles and breaking into one of them. The subjects then fled in a vehicle. Officers flooded the area and conducted a thorough search, but did not locate the subjects. Investigation revealed six auto burglaries in the vicinity. On 1/30, officers responded to multiple reports of auto burglary at a sports center on Farwell Dr. Six vehicles were broken into and had their windows smashed. These cases remain under investigation. #260130033, #260130034, #260130035, #260130036, #260130037 and #260130038

Criminal Threats/Warrant Arrest

On 1/29, officers responded to a disturbance at a residence on Beard Rd. The victim's brother (subject) broke into the home via a window. The subject had a screwdriver and threatened his brother. Upon arrival, officers determined the subject had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant and placed him under arrest. #260129003

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 1/30, officers responded to a disturbance at a residence on Dondero Way. The reporting party advised that a subject was attempting to enter his backyard. When officers arrived, the subject spontaneously emptied his pockets, revealing drug paraphernalia. The subject was placed under arrest. #260130009

Public Intoxication

On 2/1, officers responded to a disturbance at Lake Elizabeth regarding a subject yelling at park visitors. The subject showed signs of intoxication and was placed under arrest. #260201007

Residential Burglary

On 1/30, officers responded to a residential burglary on Wilford St. The victim arrived home to find the side door open and items from the residence outside. The house had been ransacked, and several thousand dollars were missing. This case remains under investigation. #260130029

On 2/1, officers responded to a residential burglary on El Dorado Common. The juvenile reporting party was home alone when they heard indications of an unknown subject in the residence. The subject fled upon hearing the reporting party. Several rooms were rummaged through. This case remains under investigation. #260201011

Robbery

On 2/2, officers responded to a robbery at a car wash on Chapel Way. Two subjects snatched a chain from one victim and struck another victim with a glass bottle. The subjects and victims were involved in a physical altercation, then the subjects entered a vehicle and drove toward the victims. The subjects fled in a vehicle but were located at a nearby residence. The subjects were placed under arrest. #260202041

Warrant Service

On 1/30, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment complex on Beacon Ave. A subject threw items at the apartments and made threats toward the reporting party. Upon arrival, officers found the subject had multiple outstanding misdemeanor warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260130010
