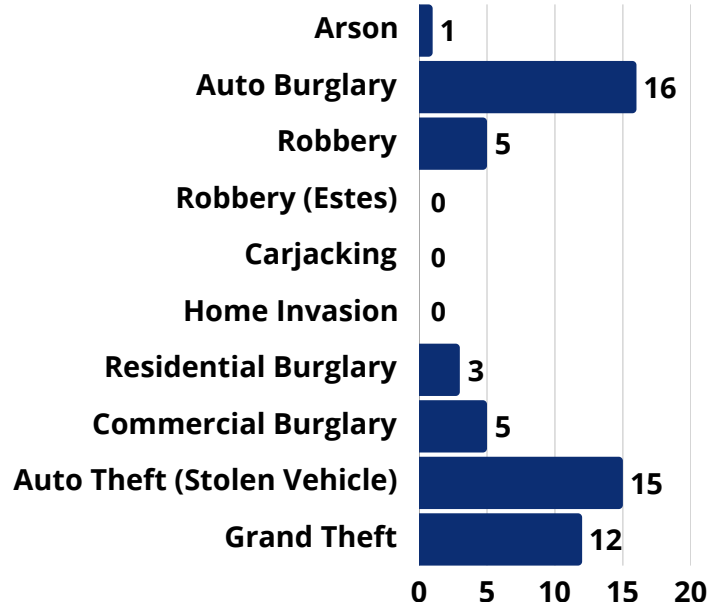

Drunk in Public

On 1/24, officers responded to a disturbance at a drugstore on Decoto Rd. A subject was opening items in the store and acting erratically. The subject was placed under arrest. #260124013

Felon in Possession of a Firearm

On 1/21, officers stopped a vehicle at Warm Springs Blvd and Warm Springs Ct for a vehicle code violation. Upon contact, officers observed a replica pistol in the back seat of the vehicle. The subject also had a loaded, unregistered handgun on his person. The subject, who had prior felony convictions, was placed under arrest. #260121029

Hit-and-Run Collision

On 1/22, officers responded to a hit-and-run collision on Farwell Dr and Roundtree Rd. A subject driving a truck collided with approximately five parked vehicles. The subject fled on foot. This case remains under investigation. #260122029

Mental Health Hold

On 1/23, officers responded to a domestic disturbance at an apartment complex on Duckling Ter. The reporting party's juvenile son (subject) used a large kitchen knife to stab the family's television, then ran away. Officers located the subject nearby, holding a large stick. After several attempts to de-escalate and negotiate with the subject, officers successfully detained the subject. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #260123039

Unlawful Fire

On 1/21, officers responded to a report of a subject setting grass on fire on Lemke Pl. The subject was walking down a trail, attempting to set foliage on fire in multiple places. The Fremont Fire Department responded and extinguished one small fire in the area. Upon arrival, officers contacted the subject and found drug paraphernalia in his possession. Petty Theft

On 1/24, officers responded to a report of auto burglary at an apartment complex on Farwell Dr. A victim's wallet and backpack were stolen out of her vehicle in the complex parking lot. Shortly afterward, the victim was notified that her credit cards had been declined at a nearby convenience store. Officers located three subjects at an area store. Two of the subjects were placed under arrest. #260124006

Robbery

On 1/20, officers responded to a robbery at a grocery store on Argonaut Way. A subject attempted to leave with alcohol and food from the store, but was confronted by the store's security. The subject spat on the two security guards, then charged at them before fleeing in a vehicle. Officers stopped the vehicle nearby and found the subject to be on active probation. The subject was placed under arrest. #260120025

On 1/22, officers responded to a robbery at a liquor store on Grimmer Blvd. A subject entered the store and asked the clerk if he could have alcohol for free. The clerk declined and told the subject to leave. Shortly afterward, the subject returned and attempted to leave the store with alcohol concealed on his person. When the clerk confronted him, the subject pushed the victim and smashed a bottle of alcohol on the floor. The subject fled and sat in a vehicle in the parking lot, where officers located him. The subject, who was on active probation, was placed under arrest. #260122019

Vandalism

On 1/21, officers responded to vandalism at a hotel on Fremont Blvd. The victim saw a subject spray painting two commercial trucks in the parking lot. When confronted, the subject threatened the victim and alluded to having a firearm. The subject fled in a vehicle. Officers located the subject at a nearby gas station and placed him under arrest. #260121001

Warrant Service

On 1/24, officers responded to a disturbance at a gas station on Mission Blvd. A subject was throwing rocks at passing vehicles. Upon arrival, officers discovered the subject had two outstanding misdemeanor warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260124003

On 1/24, officers responded to a disturbance at a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd. A subject locked himself in the bathroom several times. Upon contact, the subject was found to have multiple outstanding felony warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260124010
