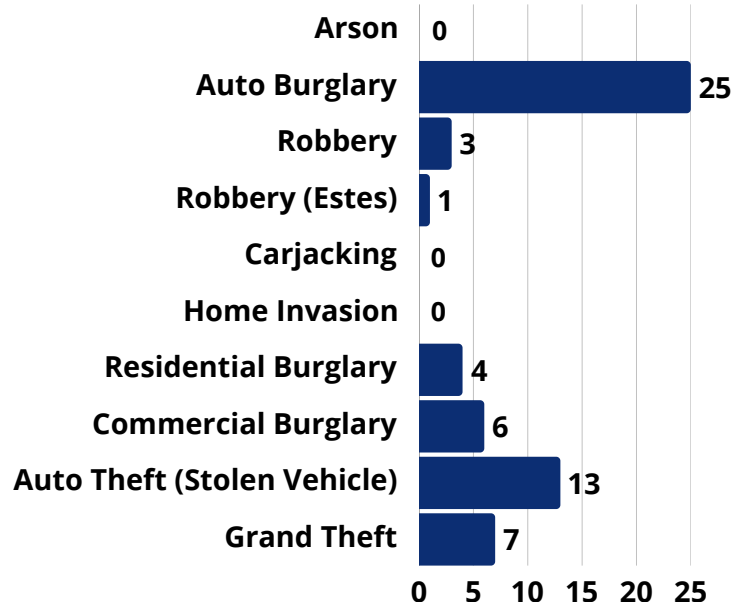




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Attempted Auto Theft

On 2/13, officers responded to an attempted auto theft at an apartment complex on Glenmoor Dr. Two subjects drove into the parking lot and pried the door handle off a parked vehicle. Upon being confronted by the vehicle's owner, the subjects fled in their own vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #260213005

## Battery

On 2/13, officers responded to a report of battery at a shopping center on Mowry Ave and State St. The victim was driving into the parking lot when a subject on a bicycle rode in front of him. The victim honked at the subject, who followed the victim to his parking space and confronted him. The subject spat in the victim's face and punched the victim's vehicle. ## Hit and Run

## Residential Burglary

On 2/10, officers responded to a residential burglary at an apartment on Fremont Blvd. The victim said her son (subject) had entered the residence through the living room window without permission. Upon seeing officers arrive, the subject fled on foot but was located nearby. He was found in possession of methamphetamine and also had an outstanding warrant. ## Robbery

On 2/14, officers responded to a robbery at a bank on Fremont Blvd. A victim was preparing to deposit cash at the ATM when a subject behind her placed her in a chokehold and took her money and purse. Another victim had just withdrawn cash when a second subject took her money and demanded more. A third subject was waiting nearby with a vehicle, and all three subjects fled in it. The vehicle was later found unoccupied in another city with the first victim's items inside. This case remains under investigation. #260214016

## Vehicle Collision

On 2/14, officers responded to a single-vehicle collision in the parking lot of a grocery store on Mission Blvd. A driver was turning into a parking space, but drove up the curb and hit a fire hydrant and a pillar in front of the store. #260214009

On 2/15, officers responded to a vehicle collision at Paseo Padre Pkwy and Fremont Blvd, involving two vehicles. One of the vehicles was found engulfed in flames, but the driver had exited the vehicle. All parties involved sustained minor injuries. #260215012

## Warrant Service

On 2/12, officers responded to a disturbance at a business on Boscell Rd. A subject was punching signs in the parking lot. Officers contacted the subject and found he had multiple outstanding felony warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260212007
