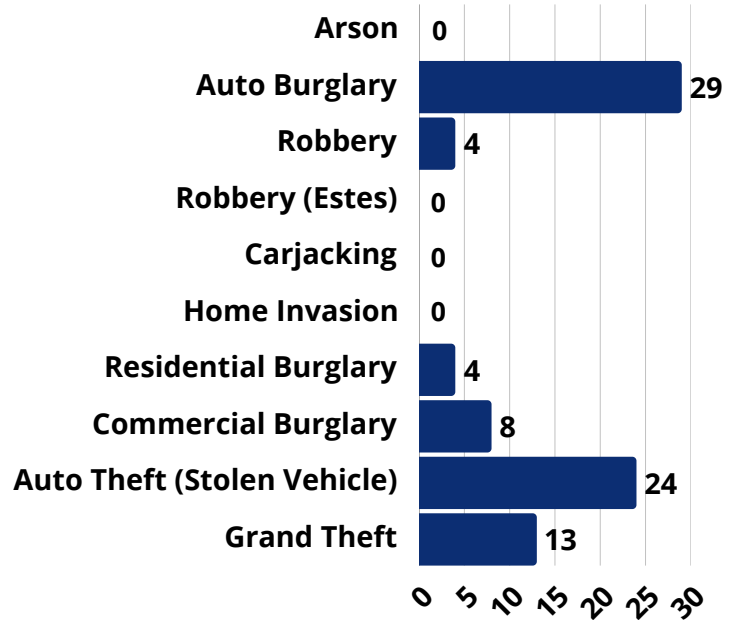

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 2/22, officers responded to an auto burglary at an apartment complex on Roberts Ave. The victim saw three subjects break into his relative's vehicle. When the victim confronted them, one subject struck him in the head with a brick. The victim went back inside, and the subjects fled on foot and motorized scooters. #260222001

Auto Burglary

Commercial Burglary

On 2/24, officers responded to an in-progress commercial burglary at a fast-food restaurant on Washington Blvd. The glass door had been shattered, and two subjects were seen inside on video surveillance footage, rummaging through drawers. The subjects fled in a vehicle at a high rate of speed before officers arrived. This case remains under investigation. #260224006

Domestic Violence

On 2/17, officers responded to a report of domestic violence in the parking lot of a hotel on Warm Springs Blvd. A subject battered his girlfriend during a physical altercation and was seen kicking her car. The subject was placed under arrest. #260217013

DUI

On 2/21, officers responded to a report of a driver passed out at the intersection of Paseo Padre Pkwy and Milton St, with the vehicle's engine still running. Officers safely placed the vehicle in park, then woke the driver. The driver was found to be on active probation and had his license suspended. He also showed signs of intoxication. Outside Assist

On 2/24, an officer located a vehicle involved in a recent copper theft committed in a nearby city. The vehicle was stopped for a traffic violation, and a large amount of copper wire was found inside. The three subjects in the vehicle were detained as the other city's law enforcement agency responded to take over the investigation. #260224004

Possession of a Controlled Substance

On 2/23, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant where a reporting party said a subject attempted to run him over with a vehicle. Officers located the vehicle in the parking lot and found the driver in possession of cocaine. The driver was placed under arrest. #260223034

Robbery

On 2/17, officers responded to a robbery at a business on Pacific Commons Blvd. The victim was leaving work when two subjects parked in front of the victim's vehicle. As the victim began to enter his vehicle, the subjects exited their vehicle and accosted the victim. One subject pointed a gun at him and grabbed him by the neck, demanding money. The other subject searched the victim's pockets and took his jewelry. The subjects fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #260217003

On 2/19, officers responded to a robbery at a liquor store on Fremont Blvd. A subject stole two drinks from the store, then threatened to kill the clerk. The subject left the store but was located nearby and placed under arrest. #260219008

On 2/23, officers responded to a robbery at a high school on Blacow Rd. A subject was trespassing during school hours, taking photos, and attempting to enter classrooms. When a teacher tried to record the subject, he forcefully took her phone from her and threw it against a wall. Upon contact, officers found the subject showing signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. #260223016

Shoplifting

On 2/18, officers responded to a report of theft at a department store on Fremont Blvd. A subject placed clothing from the store into his backpack, then left the store without paying. The subject was also drinking alcohol and yelling while in the store. Officers located the subject exiting the store and placed him under arrest. #260218036
