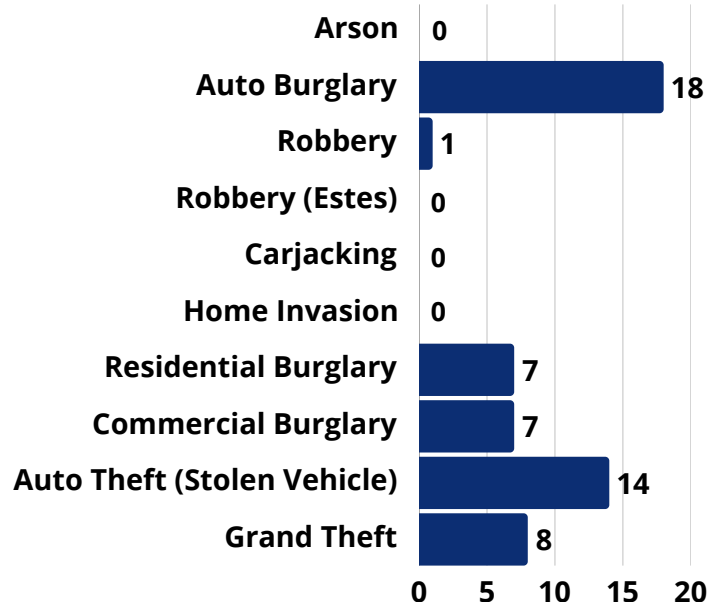

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

A loss prevention officer (victim) was in the parking lot when he saw a vehicle driving recklessly on the wrong side of the road. The victim warned the driver (subject) to drive more carefully. The subject then swerved toward the victim, hitting him in the leg. The subject was placed under arrest. #260307028

## Auto Burglary

## Commercial Burglary

On 3/8, Fremont Fire Department reported the sound of sawing in a vacant commercial building on Walnut Ave. The building was supposed to be unoccupied. Officers set up a perimeter and located a subject in the process of stealing copper wire. The subject was placed under arrest. #260308007

## Mental Health Hold

On 3/4, an officer encountered a subject wearing a bulletproof tactical vest and driving a vehicle with expired registration. The officer conducted a traffic stop and observed what appeared to be a rifle in the vehicle. The subject was hallucinating and claimed to see individuals attempting to harm him. The rifle was found to be a BB gun. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #260304006

On 3/7, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a shopping center on Blacow Rd and Grimmer Blvd. A subject was breaking the windows of businesses in the complex. Upon contact, the subject made nonsensical statements and expressed a desire for officers to harm him. ## Residential Burglary

On 3/8, officers responded to a residential burglary on Bruce Dr. A neighbor saw a subject prying the screen off the window. The subject fled before officers arrived. A search of the residence revealed that nothing was missing, but the security cameras had been disabled. This case remains under investigation. #260308004

## Robbery

On 3/9, officers responded to a robbery at the Fremont Hub. A subject entered a department store and attempted to leave with merchandise. When the store's loss prevention personnel confronted him, the subject brandished a kitchen knife from the store and fled on foot. This case remains under investigation. #260309051

## Trespassing/Indecent Exposure

On 3/5, an officer responded to a disturbance at a high school on Blacow Rd. A subject entered a classroom without permission during school hours and was scaring students. The subject refused to leave and was placed under arrest. The next day, the same subject was found sleeping in front of the entrance to a preschool in the same area. Officers asked the subject to leave, but she walked away into the school's private parking lot. The subject pulled her pants down and urinated in the parking lot. The subject was placed under arrest. #260305006 and #260306007

## Warrant Service

On 3/3, officers responded to a disturbance outside a convenience store on Mohave Dr. A subject was swinging a hatchet around. Officers safely detained the subject and found he had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. The subject was placed under arrest. #260303003

On 3/9, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment complex on Fremont Blvd. A subject was screaming as they walked around the complex. The subject was found to have two outstanding warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260309005
