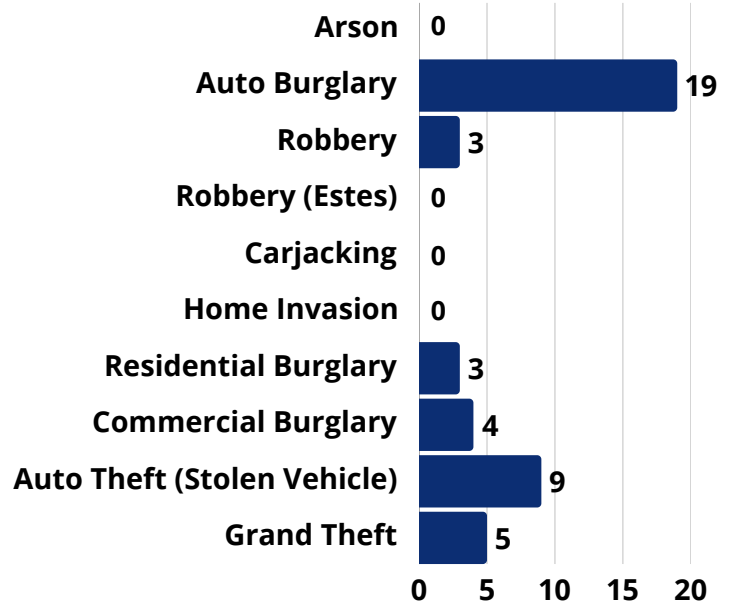

Auto Burglary

On 3/30, officers responded to an auto burglary on Mission Blvd. A subject broke into a vehicle and was sitting in the back seat, attempting to spray passersby with bug spray. The subject was combative and not compliant with officers' orders to exit the vehicle, but officers safely removed him from the vehicle and detained him. The subject was placed under arrest. #260330004

Brandishing a Weapon

On 3/30, officers responded to a disturbance near Old Warm Springs Blvd and Edison Way. A subject was chasing a victim with a metal stick and hitting parked vehicles in the area. A search of the subject revealed he had drug paraphernalia in his possession. The subject was placed under arrest. #260330022

Child Stealing

On 3/27, officers investigated a child abduction incident on Ashford Way. The child's mother (subject) had taken the child in violation of custody orders. The subject had moved out of her home and blocked phone calls from the child's father. Officers found the subject and child in a residence in a nearby city. The child was reunited with the father, and the subject was placed under arrest. #260327018

Residential Burglary

On 3/25, officers responded to a residential burglary on Fremont Blvd. A subject stole the homeowner's laptop, broke into the home, and hid in a detached garage. Officers contacted the subject, finding her in possession of drug paraphernalia. The subject was placed under arrest. #260325016

Robbery

On 3/25, officers responded to a robbery at a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. A subject stole merchandise, then brandished a firearm at an employee. The subject fled into a vehicle driven by a second subject, who attempted to run over two employees. The subjects fled but were detained by a nearby law enforcement agency in their jurisdiction. Both subjects were placed under arrest. #260325014

On 3/30, officers responded to a robbery near South Grimmer Blvd and Fremont Blvd. The reporting party was involved in a vehicle collision with a subject who refused to provide insurance information. The reporting party's wife (victim) used her phone to record the interaction, and the subject snatched it from her, then fled in his vehicle. Officers contacted the subject, who agreed to return to the scene. The subject was placed under arrest. #260330007

Shots Fired

On 3/28, officers responded to a report of battery at a liquor store on Stevenson Blvd. The reporting party indicated that five to six subjects were involved. When officers arrived, the subjects were no longer at the scene. Later that day, a gunshot victim arrived at a local hospital. The injury was related to the battery at the liquor store. This case remains under investigation. #260328003

Unlawful Peeking

On 3/30, officers responded to a report of a prowler at a residence on Parkside Dr. A subject was knocking on the front door and had attempted to force his way in through the back door. The subject was placed under arrest. #260330002

Warrant Service

On 3/27, officers responded to a disturbance on Niles Blvd, between Rock Ave and Hillview Dr. A subject was screaming at passersby and attempted to punch a vehicle. The subject had an outstanding warrant and was placed under arrest. #260327006
