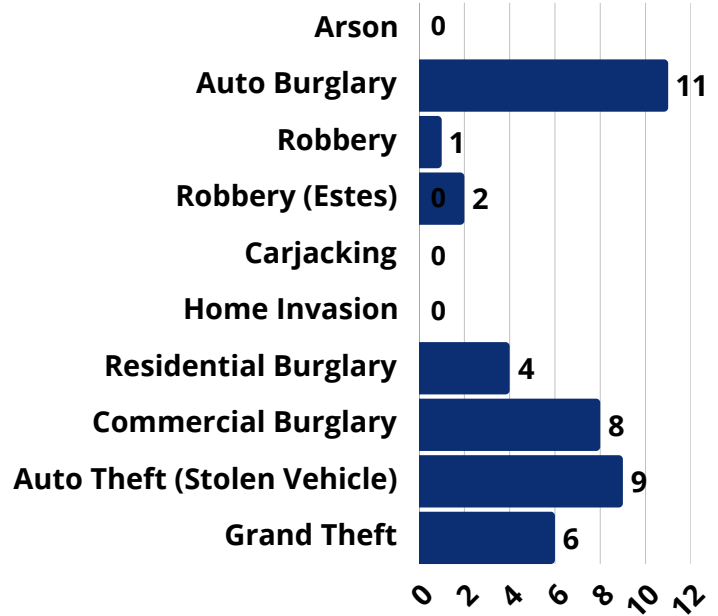

Attempted Homicide

On 4/2, officers responded to an attempted homicide near Thornton Ave and Post Ave. A victim and subject with a firearm were involved in an argument, and the subject fired at the victim. When officers arrived, the subject was sitting in his vehicle, which was parked nearby. Officers coordinated to contain the subject and confiscated the firearm. The subject was placed under arrest. #260402032

Auto Theft/Hit and Run

On 4/6, officers responded to a report of a vehicle stolen from Applewood St. Shortly afterward, the stolen vehicle was involved in a collision with another vehicle. Two subjects were seen running from the vehicle. Officers canvassed the area and eventually located both subjects, finding one to be a juvenile. Both subjects were placed under arrest and the juvenile subject was later released to family. #260406005 and #260406006

Evading Arrest

On 4/6, officers responded to a vehicle driving recklessly near Fremont Blvd and Decoto Rd. The vehicle was driving in circles in the middle of an intersection while other vehicles were present. When officers attempted to stop the vehicle, it fled at a high speed, but was ultimately stopped on Ardo St. The subject refused to comply with officers' commands and physically resisted. The subject was eventually removed from the vehicle and placed under arrest. A bag containing what is believed to be a controlled substance was found in his sock. #260407001

Fraud

On 4/1, a victim lost hundreds of thousands of dollars via a scam. Multiple subjects called the victim, claiming he was under investigation by various law enforcement agencies. One subject impersonated FPD and spoofed the non-emergency dispatch number. Over several months, one subject advised the victim to liquidate his retirement account and purchase gold. The subject then met the victim at his residence to pick up the gold. This case remains under investigation. #260401029

Indecent Exposure

On 4/2, officers responded to a disturbance at a grocery store on Mowry Ave. A subject was dancing naked on tables inside the store. Officers located the subject lying on a bench in the parking lot. The subject was placed under arrest. #260402045

Mental Health Hold

On 3/31, officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at a residence on Acacia St. A subject was attempting to enter an occupied residence. Upon contact, officers found that the subject believed the home was his own and was unable to care for himself. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #260331003

Possession of a Controlled Substance

On 4/3, officers responded to Ardentech Ct regarding a subject taking water from a fire hydrant. Upon arrival, officers contacted a subject who had a bag of methamphetamine in his possession. The subject was placed under arrest. #260403012

Robbery

On 3/31, officers responded to a robbery at a liquor store on Fremont Blvd. Two subjects jumped over the counter and stole the cash register, various alcohol bottles, and cigarettes. The subjects fled in a vehicle before officers arrived. This case remains under investigation. #260331012

Sideshow Activity

On 4/6, officers responded to multiple vehicles driving recklessly in the area of Warm Springs Blvd and Kato Rd. Upon arrival, officers found approximately 50 vehicles skidding through the intersection and approximately 300 people spectating. Officers conducted traffic enforcement on some of the vehicles, including citing one motorist and towing his vehicle. #260406003

Warrant Arrest

On 4/1, officers responded to a vacant restaurant on Fremont Blvd after the owner reported a subject inside. The subject exited the building, and officers found he had three outstanding warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260401010
