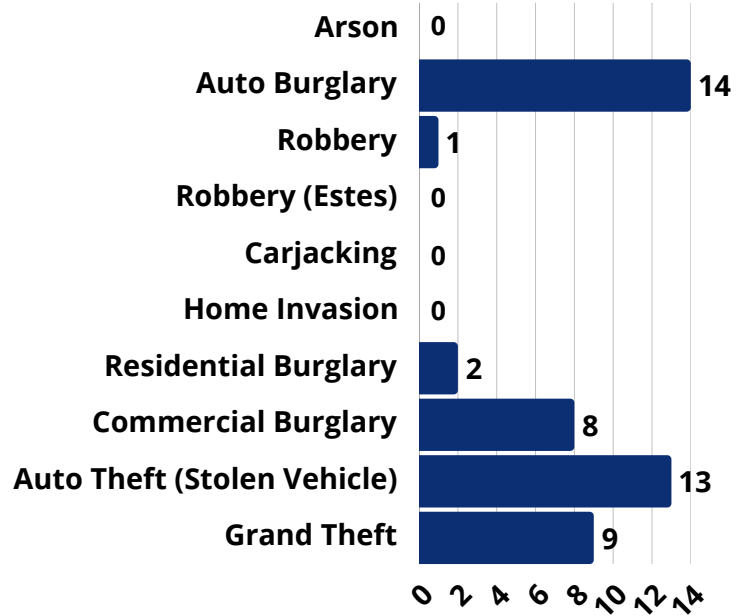

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/10, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at a residence on Starr St. A subject threw a knife at his neighbor (victim). The victim was struck by the handle of the knife. The victim also had a restraining order against the subject, preventing him from contacting the victim. Officers placed the subject under arrest. #260410006

Battery

On 4/8, officers responded to several reports of a fight near Capitol Ave and Fremont Blvd. Several subjects were involved, including multiple juveniles. Officers separated the parties involved. Three adult subjects were placed under arrest, and one juvenile subject was issued a Notice to Appear. #260408027

On 4/11, officers responded to a report of battery at a liquor store on Thornton Ave. A subject approached a victim and asked to use the phone. When the victim refused, the subject punched him several times. The subject was placed under arrest. #260411001

Brandishing a Weapon

On 4/8, officers responded to a report of brandishing a weapon near Edison Way and Yale Way. The victim was driving when a subject threw an object at her vehicle. The subject also brandished what appeared to be a machete at the victim. The subject was placed under arrest. #260408022

Criminal Threats

On 4/12, officers responded to a report of criminal threats at an apartment on San Pedro Dr. A subject threatened to shoot his parents and attempted to hit his father. The subject was placed under arrest. #260412016

Domestic Violence

On 4/12, officers responded to a report of domestic violence at a residence on Cromwell Place. A subject struck the victim and threw items at him, causing multiple visible injuries. The subject was placed under arrest, and an emergency protective order was secured for the victim. #260412012

DUI

On 4/7, officers responded to the area of Mission Blvd and Mill Creek Rd regarding a vehicle that slid off the roadway and was partially disabled in the embankment. The driver was found to be intoxicated and was placed under arrest. #260407027

Negligent Discharge of a Firearm in a Building/Carrying Concealed Firearm

On 4/10, officers responded to a suspicious circumstance in a restaurant on Albrae St after an employee heard a firearm discharge in the restroom. Officers determined that a subject had accidentally discharged the firearm, and a bullet hole was found in the mirror. The subject agreed to meet officers and surrendered his firearm, magazines, and ammunition. The subject was placed under arrest. #260410001

Mail Theft

On 4/9, officers responded to a motel on Fremont Blvd regarding a subject with an active felony warrant and on searchable probation. Officers found mail that did not belong to the subject, drug paraphernalia, and ID and credit cards bearing a variety of different names. Mail from 12 different victims was found. The subject was placed under arrest. #260409046

Vehicle Collision

On 4/8, at 6:55 a.m., Fremont Police received reports of a vehicle collision near Mission Blvd and Niles Canyon Rd. Officers responded and discovered that a passenger vehicle had hit an electrical box, resulting in a power outage and traffic light outage in the immediate vicinity. Caltrans advised that the traffic signals will remain out of service for several hours. As congestion began to build, Fremont Police issued an advisory to avoid the area. #P26037455

Vandalism/Trespassing

On 4/10, officers responded to a report of residential burglary on Melero Common. A juvenile reporting party was home alone when his uncle (subject) broke into the home by smashing a glass door. The reporting party hid in a bathroom as the subject broke items in the house. Officers quickly secured the reporting party and searched the residence, but the subject had fled before officers arrived. This case will be forwarded to the District Attorney's Office. #260410007
