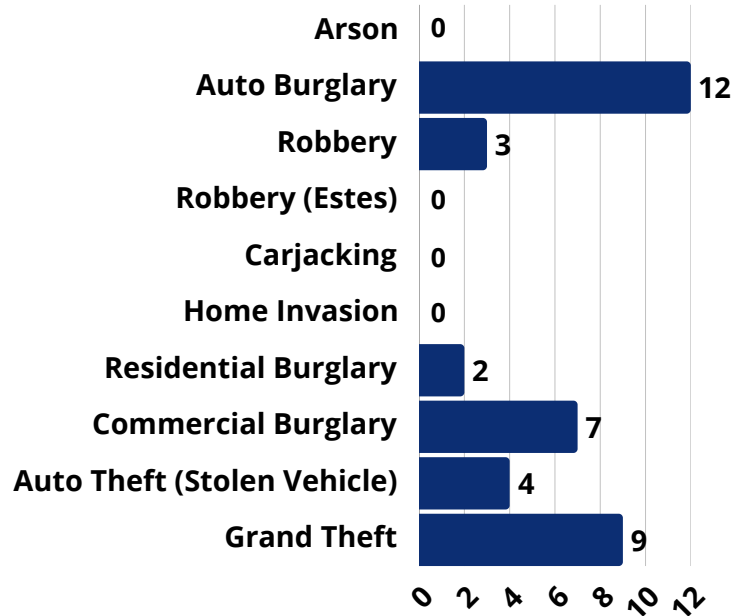

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/17, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at a convenience store on Fremont Blvd. A subject was involved in a dispute with her neighbor and battered him, then struck him with a beer bottle. The subject fled back to her apartment, nearby. The subject was placed under arrest. #260417024

Criminal Threats

On 4/16, officers responded to a disturbance at the Navigation Center on Capitol Ave. A subject was waving a firearm and threatening employees. The subject was placed under arrest, and a replica firearm was found in her bag. #260416017

Mental Health Hold

On 4/17, officers responded to multiple reports of a disturbance at a café on Stevenson Blvd. A naked subject was crawling across the floor of the café. Officers found the subject under a truck parked in the driveway of a nearby residence. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #260417008

Robbery

On 4/16, officers responded to a robbery in the parking lot of a liquor store on Thornton Ave. The victim was standing outside his vehicle when a subject with a firearm demanded money from him. The subject took the victim's backpack and fled on foot. This case remains under investigation. #260416003

On 4/19, officers responded to a robbery at a residence on Sundale Dr. The victim interrupted a subject stealing shoes from his front porch. When the victim confronted the subject, he threatened the victim with a knife. The subject fled wearing the victim's shoes, leaving his own shoes behind. This case remains under investigation. #260419021

Shots Fired

On 4/15, officers responded to a shooting at an apartment building on Old Warm Springs Blvd, after a resident reported finding a bullet hole in the exterior wall of his unit's bathroom. Officers located 4 bullet strikes on an external wall. The investigation revealed that a subject had been shooting rounds into a brick wall in the parking garage. The subject was found to be another resident of the building and was the subject of a gun violence restraining order. The subject's wife, who resided in the same unit, also had a gun violence restraining order. Officers searched the unit and found a firearm, gun parts and accessories, ammunition, and what is believed to be cocaine. Both the subject and his wife were placed under arrest. #260415021

Sideshow Activity

On 4/18, officers responded to reports of sideshow activity near Landing Pkwy and Warren Ave. Approximately 75 to 100 vehicles were present. Officers flooded the area, causing the vehicles to disperse. The vehicles attempted to reconvene later that evening at Kato Rd and Milmont Dr, then again at Alvarado Blvd and Deep Creek Rd. Officers dispersed the group on both occasions, and it did not return for the rest of the evening. #P26041461

On 4/19, officers responded to reports of sideshow activity near Lakeview Blvd and Gateway Blvd. Approximately 50 to 60 vehicles were present. Officers responded and dispersed the vehicles without further incident. Officers continued to proactively patrol for the rest of the evening, and no additional gatherings or sideshow activities were reported. #P26041847

Stolen Vehicle

On 4/16, detectives located a stolen vehicle stopped near Acacia St and Parkmont Dr. Officers apprehended the driver, but the passenger fled on foot through a nearby elementary school. The school was placed on shelter-in-place and the subject fled into the residential area. The subject was located in a backyard and eventually surrendered. Both the driver (adult) and passenger (juvenile) were placed under arrest. #260416006

Vandalism

On 4/16, officers responded to multiple reports of vandalism at a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd. A subject was yelling and smashing vehicles with a bat. The subject was placed under arrest. #260416030

On 4/17, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd. A subject threw a rock through the restaurant's window. The subject was placed under arrest. #260417002
