Armed Robbery Investigation

On 4/21, officers responded to a late-reported armed robbery near the Sullivan Underpass. The juvenile victim reported being robbed of a backpack by two suspects armed with handguns. Officers located the suspect vehicle near the Tom Blalock corridor and conducted a high-risk traffic stop. Officers safely detained multiple occupants, including one juvenile who was positively identified as one of the robbery suspects. Another juvenile suspect associated with the incident was located and detained at a residence on Porter St. The case remains under investigation. #260421026

Drunk in Public

On 4/23, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment complex on Sundale Dr. A subject battered the victim and attempted to enter the driver's seat of his vehicle. Officers contacted the subject, finding her displaying signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. #260423032

On 4/24, officers responded to a possible burglary at a residence on Charleston Way. A subject broke into the backyard and attempted to enter the house. Officers contacted the subject, who displayed signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. #260424001

On 4/25, officers responded to a report of indecent exposure at a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd. A subject pulled his pants down to his ankles. Officers contacted the subject, finding him drinking alcohol and showing signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. #260425016

On 4/21, officers responded to a report of indecent exposure at a laundromat on Fremont Blvd. A subject was completely nude inside the laundromat. A patron at the laundromat told the subject to put his clothes on, and the subject complied, then left in a vehicle. Officers located the subject and placed him under arrest. #260421012

Negligent Discharge of a BB Gun

On 4/24, officers responded to a possible shooting at a residence on Yerba Buena Pl. A resident saw a subject in a parked vehicle shooting what appeared to be a rifle toward nearby homes. Upon arrival, officers determined that the rifle was a pellet gun, and the subject had fired multiple shots toward a residence. The subject was placed under arrest. #260424009

Outside Assist

On 4/22, officers responded to assist the Fremont Fire Department with a subject who had a gunshot wound. The subject was doing her son's laundry, and when she placed the laundry basket on the ground, a firearm went off, striking her. The subject was unaware of the firearm prior to the discharge, and it did not belong to her. Officers collected the firearm from the subject. #260422024

Robbery

On 4/26, officers responded to a robbery at a hardware store on Ice House Terrace. A subject concealed a hammer and saw blades on his person, then attempted to leave the store. When loss prevention personnel confronted him, the subject brandished the hammer at them, then fled on foot. Officers located the subject and placed him under arrest. #260426012

Stolen Vehicle

On 4/23, at approximately 1:32 a.m., officers responded to a report of a stolen vehicle driving erratically on the 5500 block of Cushing Pkwy. A subject barricaded himself inside the vehicle. On 4/26, an officer located a stolen vehicle driving near Paseo Padre Pkwy and Bowling Green Common. After the officer attempted to stop the vehicle, it fled at a high rate of speed. The officer located the vehicle again near Ardenwood Blvd and Commerce Dr and observed the driver (subject) and passenger flee on foot into a housing complex. Officers set up a perimeter and located the subject hiding in the side yard of a residence. The subject was placed under arrest. #260426004

Unlawful Fire

On 4/23, the Fremont Fire Department reported an encampment fire that appeared to be set intentionally near Kaiser Dr and Ardenwood Blvd. A subject was standing by the fire and stoking it. The fire spread to a nearby log and brush on the hillside before FFD extinguished it. Officers identified the subject, finding that he had previously set multiple fires in the same encampment. This case will be forward for charging. #260423034
