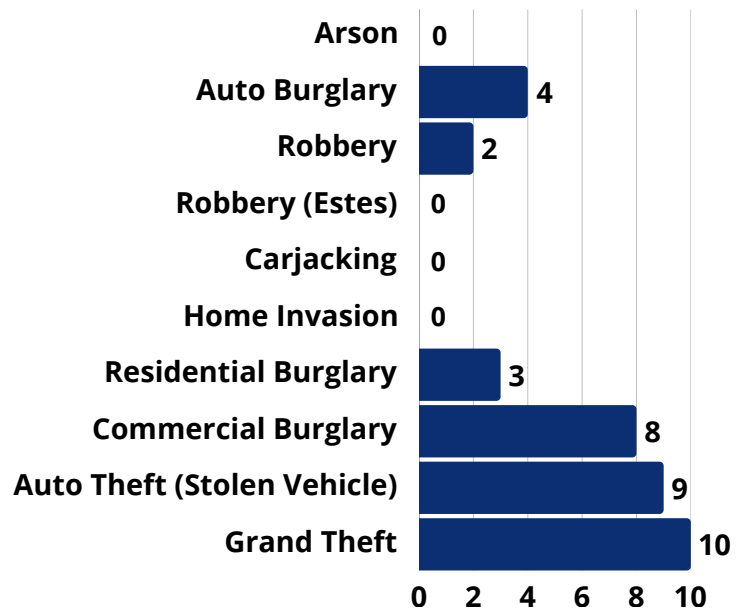




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Burglary

On 4/30, officers responded to a burglary at a residence on Mission Blvd. The property has a warehouse on site, and a subject was cutting the locks to the warehouse. Officers established a perimeter and contacted two subjects on the property. One subject was placed under arrest. #260430023

On 5/1, officers responded to a burglary at a residence on Linmore Dr. A victim arrived home to find the garage door open. Officers cleared the house, finding it ransacked. Two firearms were missing. #260501002

## Child Endangerment

On 5/4, officers responded to the area of Gable Dr and McDuff Ave for a welfare check. A subject was unconscious on the ground, and a young juvenile was attempting to wake him. The juvenile was standing near the roadway and was not under the supervision of a responsible adult. The subject regained consciousness and showed signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. The juvenile's grandmother was contacted, and the juvenile was given to her care. #260504028

## Domestic Violence

On 5/4, officers responded to a report of domestic violence at a residence on Canyon Heights Dr. A subject pointed a firearm toward his wife (victim) and threatened to kill her. The victim separated from the subject, and the subject surrendered when officers arrived. ## Mental Health Hold

On 4/29, officers responded to a disturbance at a residence on Savannah Rd. A subject was threatening his brother and threw a knife at him. Officers created a contact plan and successfully de-escalated the situation. The subject cooperated and was placed on a mental health hold. #260429022

## Robbery

On 4/30, officers responded to a robbery at a department store on Fremont Blvd. Two subjects ripped security tags off clothing and stuffed them into bags from the store. The store's loss prevention personnel confronted the subjects and attempted to retrieve the merchandise. One subject threatened the loss prevention personnel, but eventually both subjects surrendered the merchandise. Officers placed both subjects under arrest. #260430029

## Sideshow Activity

On 5/3, officers received intelligence from surrounding agencies about a sideshow planned for the areas of Milmont Dr and Kato Rd, and Technology Dr and S. Grimmer Blvd. Officers flooded the areas, as well as other known areas throughout the city. Approximately 40 to 50 vehicles were seen attempting to access the two areas, but due to increased police presence, no sideshows materialized. #P26047126

## Trespassing

On 5/3, officers responded to a disturbance at a fast-food restaurant on Stevenson Blvd. A subject was pounding on the windows and doors, scaring customers. When officers arrived, the subject agreed to leave the business. Officers issued a trespass notice to the subject. #260503005

## Vandalism

On 5/1, officers responded to a vandalism incident in a parking lot on Mowry Ave. A subject was involved in an argument with a victim. The victim left in a vehicle and the subject followed him. As the two were stopped at an intersection, the subject punched out the window of the victim's vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest. #260501033

## Violation of a Court Order

On 5/2, officers responded to a report of a court order violation on Raven Terrace. The reporting party's two children were picked up by their mother (subject) earlier that day. In violation of a valid court order, the subject did not return the children on the same day. Officers located the subject and two children at a hotel in a nearby city. The subject was placed under arrest. #260502004
