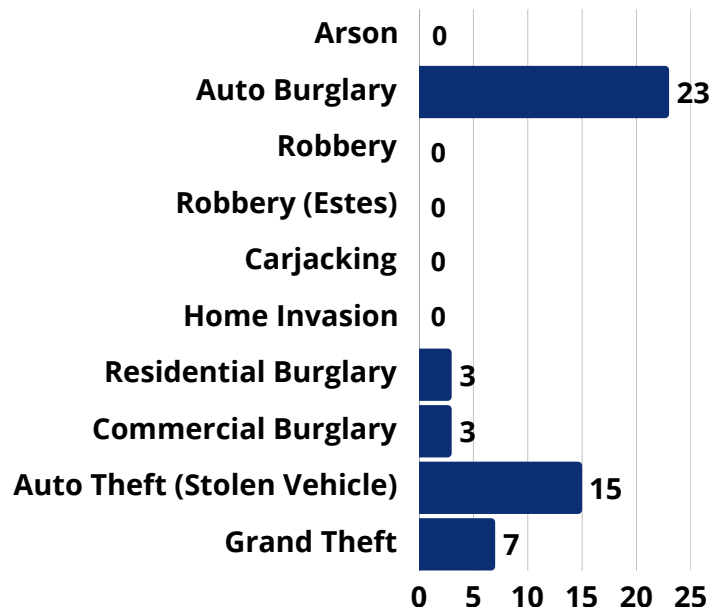

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 5/15, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at a convenience store on Mission Blvd. A subject was holding a stick and throwing rocks at the building, then chased the store clerk and threw rocks at him. The subject was placed under arrest. #260515001

On 5/15, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at a convenience store on Mowry Ave. A subject asked for cigarettes but was unable to pay for them. When the clerk said he would not give the cigarettes away for free, the subject struck him with a metal water bottle. Officers found the subject walking nearby and placed him under arrest. #260515015

## Manufacturing a Controlled Substance

On 5/13, officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at a hotel on Farwell Pl. Hotel staff found a box containing several items that may be used for manufacturing methamphetamine. The items were collected and tested positive for methamphetamine. The subject who left the items had checked into a different hotel and officers contacted him at his hotel room. With assistance from the Major Crimes Task Force (MCTF), officers noted that it appeared the subject was preparing to begin manufacturing methamphetamine. The subject was placed under arrest. #260513017

## Public Nuisance

On 5/14, officers responded to a disturbance at a school on Fremont Blvd. A subject was urinating in public as teachers and students were arriving. School administrators had received multiple complaints about the subject, who was staring at children while drinking alcohol. Officers contacted the subject and placed him under arrest. #260514007

## Shooting Incident

## Stolen Vehicle

On 5/14, officers responded to a report of a stolen vehicle near Union St and Fremont Blvd. The victim parked on the corner and left the vehicle running as he went to pick up food. When the victim returned, the vehicle was gone. Officers used video surveillance to track the vehicle, which remained in the city. Approximately one hour after the theft, officers located the vehicle and contacted the driver (subject), who admitted to stealing it. The subject was placed under arrest and the vehicle was returned to the victim. #260514001

## Vandalism

On 5/14, officers responded to a report of vandalism near Stevenson Blvd and Blacow Rd. The victim was stopped at a red light when a subject in another vehicle threw items at her vehicle, damaging it. The subject was yelling and pointing a firearm toward the ceiling. The victim drove away without further incident. This case remains under investigation. #260514011

On 5/17, officers responded to a disturbance around Fremont Blvd and Sundale Dr. The reporting party saw a subject throw luggage at her vehicle. Employees at a nearby business reported that the subject was screaming and attempting to fight one of their staff members, causing employees to barricade inside. The subject broke the door to the business and was found inside a nearby liquor store. Upon contact, officers found the subject showing signs of intoxication, and the subject was resistant to officers during detention. The subject was placed under arrest. #260517017

## Warrant Service

On 5/18, officers responded to a disturbance at a school on Stevenson Blvd. A subject was brandishing a long tree branch at vehicles in the parking lot and jumping in front of vehicles. Officers contacted the subject and found he had multiple outstanding warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #260518028
