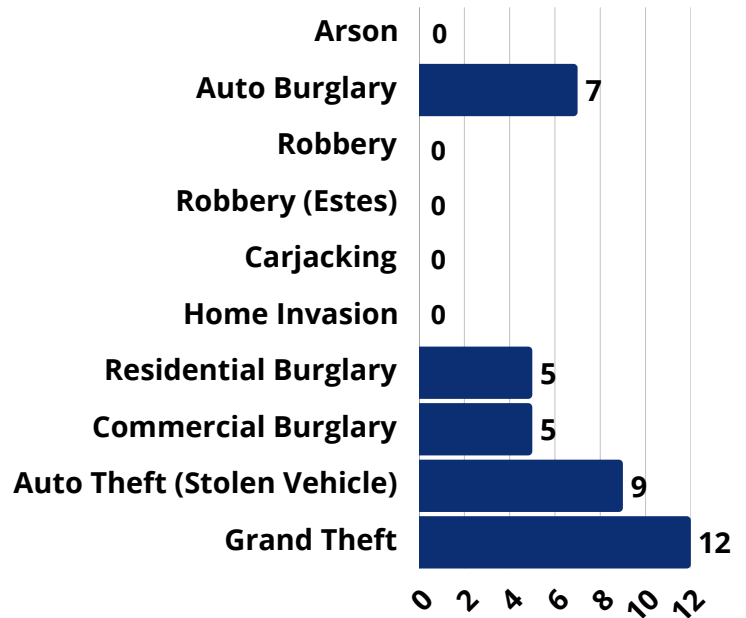

Auto Burglary

On 5/25, officers responded to reports of a subject driving recklessly near Marshlands Road. A subject broke an unoccupied vehicle's window, then fled in his own vehicle. Multiple reporting parties reported that the subject was driving recklessly, threw a bottle of alcohol out of his window while driving, and collided with several parked cars. The subject blew a tire on a curb and fled on foot, but a witness restrained him until officers arrived. The subject was placed under arrest. #260525014 and #260525015

Commercial Burglary

On 5/23, officers responded to a disturbance at a commercial building on Paseo Padre Pkwy. The property manager advised that a subject was in the conference room with various belongings. The subject was not authorized to be inside the building but had the keys to it. The subject also had burglary tools. The subject was placed under arrest. #260523032

Drunk in Public

On 5/23, officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at an apartment on Red Hawk Terrace. A resident reported that a subject stood at her door for approximately 10 minutes, attempting to open the door. Officers contacted the subject, who showed signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. #260523009

DUI

On 5/26, officers responded to a single vehicle collision in the area of Mission Blvd and Driscoll Rd. The involved vehicle collided with a tree and sheared a traffic signal pole, resulting in an outage of the area traffic signal. The driver was uninjured but was determined to be under the influence and was placed under arrest. No injuries were reported. #260526002.

Grand Theft

On 5/21, officers responded to a disturbance at a coffee shop on Paseo Padre Pkwy. A victim previously purchased gold bars from a subject, but had discovered they were counterfeit. The victim arranged to meet with the subject at the coffee shop and confronted him about the counterfeit gold. The subject refused to refund the victim and attempted to throw away his counterfeit gold items. Upon arrival, officers found the subject in possession of several items that appeared to be counterfeit gold and watches for sale. The subject was placed under arrest. #260521025

Kidnapping

On 5/22, officers responded to a report of a battery at a smoke shop on Fremont Blvd. A juvenile victim was standing outside when several other juvenile subjects approached him. The subjects battered the victim, then forced him into a vehicle. The vehicle stopped at a smoke shop, where the subjects demanded the victim buy electronic cigarettes for them. The victim called 9-1-1, and the subjects fled in the vehicle. Officers responded to a report of several juveniles involved in a fight at a shopping center and located the subjects in a nearby vehicle. Three juvenile subjects were placed under arrest, issued Notices to Appear, then released to their parents. #260522036

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 5/25, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment on Lexington St. A resident reported that his cousin (subject) jumped onto his patio and was hitting the wall and door with a long piece of wood. Officers conducted a probation search on the subject and found drug paraphernalia in his possession. The subject was placed under arrest. #260525010

Stolen Vehicle

On 5/21, officers responded to a stolen vehicle at a grocery store on Warm Springs Blvd. The victim was inside the store and watched a subject drive away in his vehicle. Officers located and stopped the vehicle around Auto Mall Pkwy and Montrose Ave. The subject refused to comply with the officers' commands and barricaded himself inside the vehicle. The subject drove away, but officers later located the vehicle, finding it driving recklessly throughout the city. Eventually, the subject struck another vehicle and came to a stop. The subject was placed under arrest. #260521017

Trespassing

On 5/24, officers responded to a report of trespassing at a middle school on Irvington Ave. A subject jumped a fence and entered the school's gated area. The subject had previously been arrested for trespassing at another school. The subject was placed under arrest. #260524008
