

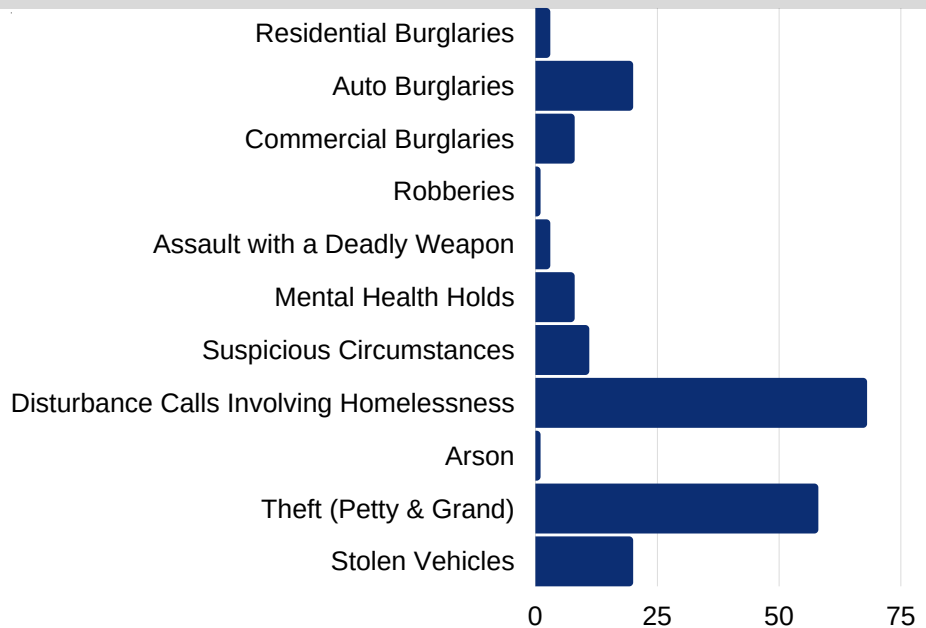


# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Assault With Deadly Weapon

On 7/25/20 officers responded to two people fighting in a field adjacent to the Centerville Jack in the Box. Jose Cohetero-Pantoja (30) accused the victim of stealing his cell phone before striking her multiple times with a metal nozzle attached to a garden hose. This caused minor injury. Cohetero pulled a knife and jabbed at the victim without making contact. Cohetero was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and booked at the Fremont Jail. # 200725001

On 7/30/20, officers responded to a disturbance near Lake Elizabeth involving a homeless male. Two workers were cleaning bathrooms at the park when the male, Dominique Roffener (31), became upset because they woke him. Roffener grabbed a wooden pole/baton and attempted to hit both workers but was unsuccessful. Roffener then smashed their vehicle's windshield before fleeing through the park. He was contacted at the Fremont Library and was arrested for two counts of assault with a deadly weapon and vandalism. He was booked at Santa Rita Jail. #200730005

### Battery on Peace Officer

On 07/26/20, officers responded to a homeless male exposing himself on Grimmer Blvd near Valpey Park Ave. It was reported the male was walking around with his pants down and grabbed a female. Officers located Jeffrey Augello (37). Augello decided to spit on an officer and stomp on the officer's feet during a pat search. Augello was arrested for battery on a peace officer. # 200726030

### Brandishing a Weapon/Felony Vandalism/Warrant Arrest

On 07/28/20, officers responded to a male trying to enter residences on Carol Av near Grimmer. Officers contacted known probationer Jeffrey Odell (29) who smashed his meth pipe on the ground in front of the officer. Odell had an active warrant for battery of an AC Transit bus driver. Odell was taken into custody. #200728038

On 07/29/20, officers responded to a caller advising a male holding a machete approached his vehicle near the Burger King at 5 Corners. The caller drove away noting the male put the machete down his pants. When the caller arrived home, he noticed the male had caused damage his vehicle. Officers located Jeffrey Odell (29) and arrested him following positive identification by the victim. Odell was arrested for vandalism, brandishing a weapon, and carrying a concealed dagger. #200729035

On 07/30/20, officers responded to Carol Ave regarding a male using a machete to scratch a vehicle. Officers again located the person Jeff Odell (29), who fled from the officers. Odell is still outstanding. #200730019

On 07/27/20, officers responded to the area of Decoto Rd and Interstate 880 regarding a collision. One of the drivers, Lamonte McGehee (31), was arrested for driving under the influence of an alcohol. #200727001

On 7/30/20, officers responded to Mission Valley Shopping Center regarding a man breaking car windows with a baseball bat. Officers contacted Troy Mounsey (50) who was intoxicated and arrested him for drunk in public. #200730028

## **Residential Burglary**

On 07/25/2020, officers responded to a home burglary in progress in the 1300 block of Valdez Way . The caller dialed 911 after waking up to find a female entering his residence through an unlocked door. Officers located Loren Lawrence (20) and arrested her for burglary of an inhabited residence. #200725005.

## **Shooting at an Unoccupied Vehicle**

On 7/25/20, officers responded to a shooting in the 4400 block of Central Ave. A parked vehicle was struck by gunfire. This is the second shooting in this area this week. Officers are conducting extra patrol checks in the area and the shootings are being investigated by the Joint Major Crimes Task Force. #200726005
