

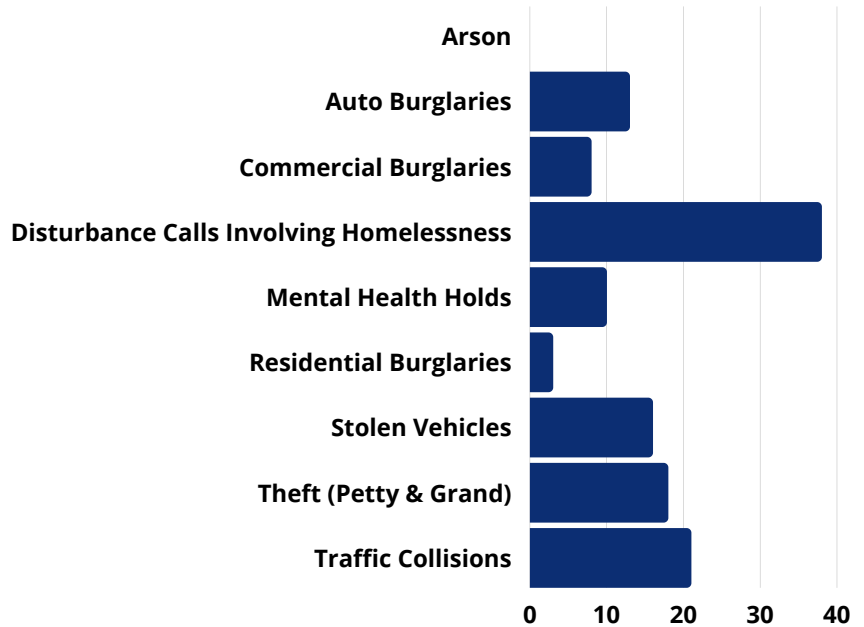

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 5/05 at approximately 3:42 p.m. officers responded to a report of an assault with a deadly weapon at Big Five Sporting Goods, 3820 Mowry Ave. A subject entered the store, grabbed a baseball bat and threatened to hit an employee with it before taking a swing. Officers located the suspect walking away from the store. Anthony Pablo (22) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210508018

Auto Theft

On 5/04 at approximately 10:59 a.m. officers located a stolen vehicle at the 76 Gas Station, 4190 Mowry Ave. Michelle Rivera (25) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210504016

Commercial Burglary

On 5/04 between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. a commercial burglary occurred at Best Bay Law, 4024 Bay St. A window at the business had been shattered and the victim discovered their office door barricaded. When the victim tried to open the door, an unknown subject announced he had been sleeping inside the business. The suspect fled the scene before officers arrived. #210504008

The suspect pulled out a knife and threatened the victim before continuing to flee the scene. Officers quickly located the suspect nearby.
