

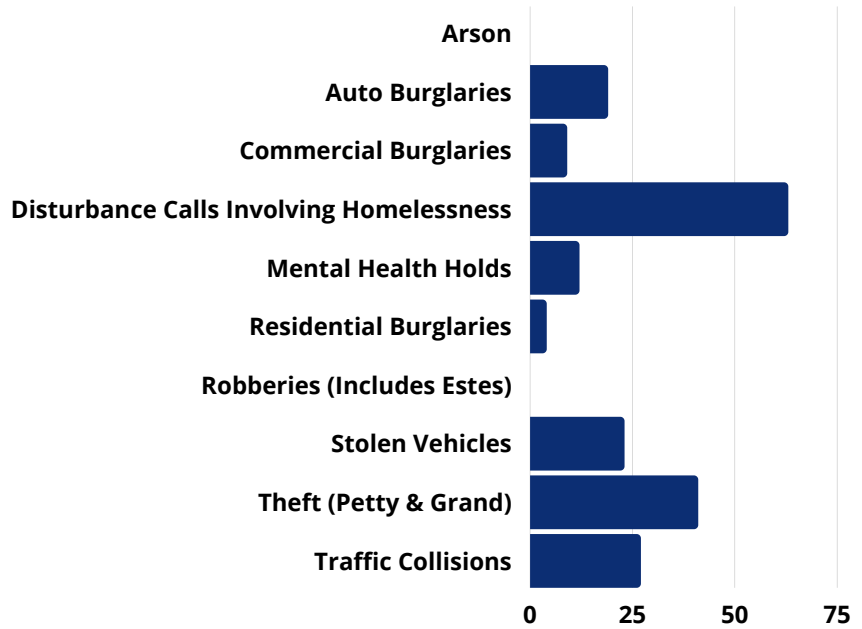


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 11/09 at approximately 1:50 a.m. an auto burglary occurred at Safeway, 3902 Washington Blvd. A suspect was later identified and the case was sent for charging. #211109002

Auto Theft

On 11/09 at approximately 6:00 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Cushing Pkwy and Northport Loop. A felony traffic stop was conducted and a male suspect was detained. Joaquin Beza (31) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #211109005

On 11/09 at approximately 6:41 p.m. a purse theft occurred at Civic Center Dr and Bart Wy. Victim was seated on a bench with her purse next to her when a suspect emerged from the bushes, grabbed her purse, and began running southbound on Civic Center Dr with a second suspect. #211110038
