

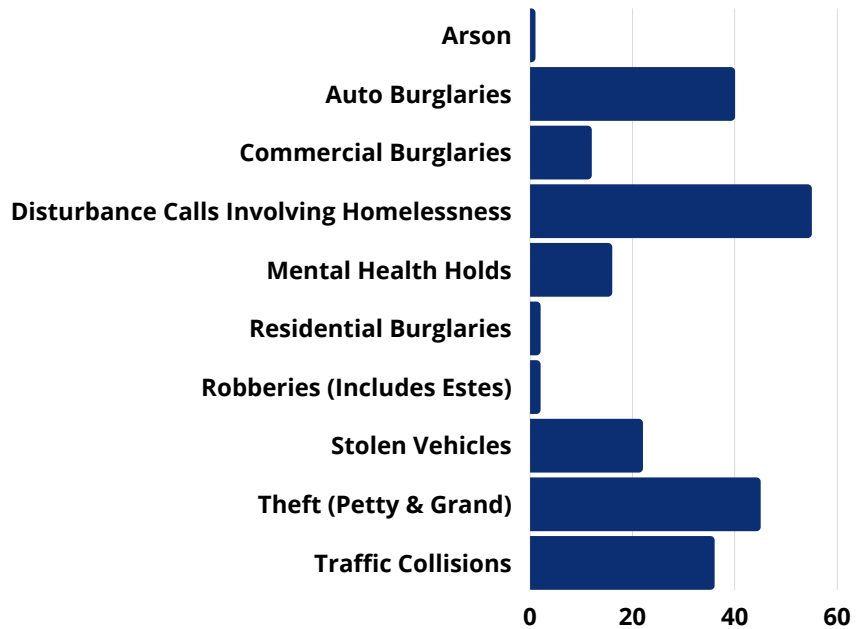


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 12/14 at approximately 9:02 p.m. an auto burglary occurred at The Globe Shopping Center, 6004 Stevenson Blvd. Suspect(s) shattered a rear window and removed items. #211214045

Robbery

On 12/15 at approximately 6:32 p.m. officers responded to an active fight at the Union 76 Gas Station, 4190 Mowry Ave. Officers arrived on scene and immediately located two suspects that attempted to flee the area. It was determined a robbery had occurred inside the business and an employee was involved in an altercation with the two suspects. Theft
