

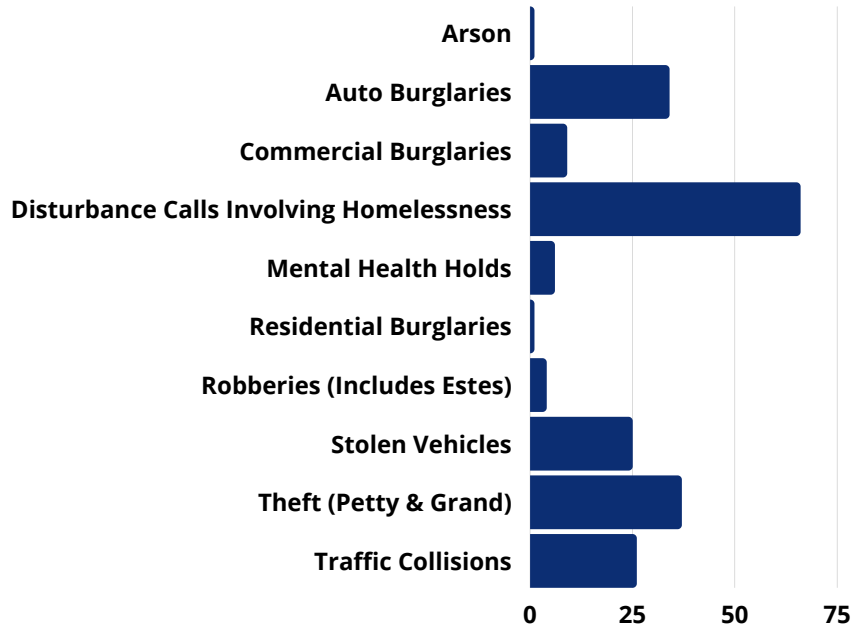


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Theft

On 1/09 at approximately 3:27 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle at the 76 Gas Station, 4190 Mowry Ave. Officers arrested the suspect as he exited the vehicle. A loaded handgun and ammunition were recovered from inside the vehicle. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220109019

Carjacking

On 1/04 at approximately 8:14 a.m. a carjacking occurred at Shinn Park, 1251 Peralta Blvd. Victim was sitting in her vehicle when a male suspect opened her door and forced her out of the vehicle. The suspect immediately fled the scene in the victim's vehicle. A few minutes later, a robbery was reported at a nearby 7-Eleven, 482 Mowry Ave. The description of the suspect vehicle matched the vehicle that had just been carjacked. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect inside of the store. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220104007

Commercial Burglary

On 1/09 at approximately 10:45 p.m. a commercial burglary occurred at Fletcher Jones Mercedes, 5760 Cushing Pkwy. Suspect(s) forced entry to the business via a glass door and removed items. #220110008

Indecent Exposure

On 1/04 at approximately 11:00 a.m. an indecent exposure occurred outside of 42200 Albrae St. Victim was standing in the area when a male suspect exposed himself and began masturbating. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect nearby. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220104018

Robbery

On 1/10 at approximately 4:09 p.m. a robbery occurred in the area of Ohlones St. Two elderly victims were walking in the area when they were approached by a male and female suspect in a vehicle. The suspects engaged the victims in conversation and proceeded to swap their jewelry for fake pieces before fleeing the scene. #220110034

Residential Burglary

On 1/09 between 5:35 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. a residential burglary attempt occurred in the area of Benchmark Ave. A male suspect attempted to follow the victim inside her residence and began kicking the front door repeatedly. Officers located the suspect nearby and detained him. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220109005

Theft

On 1/08 at approximately 2:10 p.m. a grand theft occurred at Dick's Sporting Goods, 43923 Pacific Commons Blvd. Suspect entered the store and took over \$1,000 worth of merchandise that had not been paid for. #220109405
