

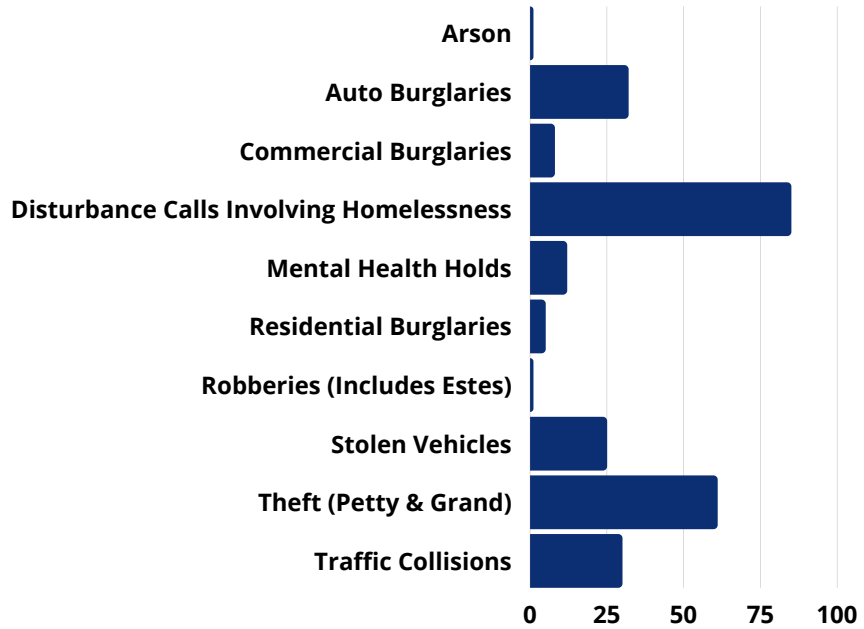


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 1/22 at approximately 12:22 a.m. an arson occurred in the area of Boscell Co. and Christy St. Officers responded to reports of a small fire near an RV. A vehicle was observed fleeing from the area and a high-risk vehicle stop was conducted. Evidence linking the driver to the fire was recovered and the suspect was detained. James Azevedo (46) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220122002

Brandishing

On 1/21 at approximately 6:27 a.m. a brandishing weapon incident occurred at Niles Donuts, 38003 Mission Blvd. A male suspect was swinging an axe and brandishing it a people. The suspect left the area before police arrived. #220121006

Carjacking

On 1/24 at approximately 12:40 a.m. a carjacking occurred in the parking lot of the Extended Stay America, 46312 Mission Blvd. Victim was seated in a vehicle when two male suspects approached and opened the passenger door. On 1/19 at approximately 6:25 p.m. a robbery occurred at Poki Poke, 34460 Fremont Blvd. Two suspects entered the store and stole the cash register at gunpoint before fleeing. #220119033

Shooting

On 1/23 at approximately 1:03 a.m. officers responded to reports of a shooting at Encore Karaoke, 46132 Warm Springs Blvd. Shell casings were located at the scene but no injuries were reported. It was discovered a fight had broken out and the suspect fired off rounds before fleeing in a vehicle. The suspect was identified and located nearby. A loaded gun was recovered from the vehicle. Mingrun Song (27) out of Cupertino was arrested. #220123003
