

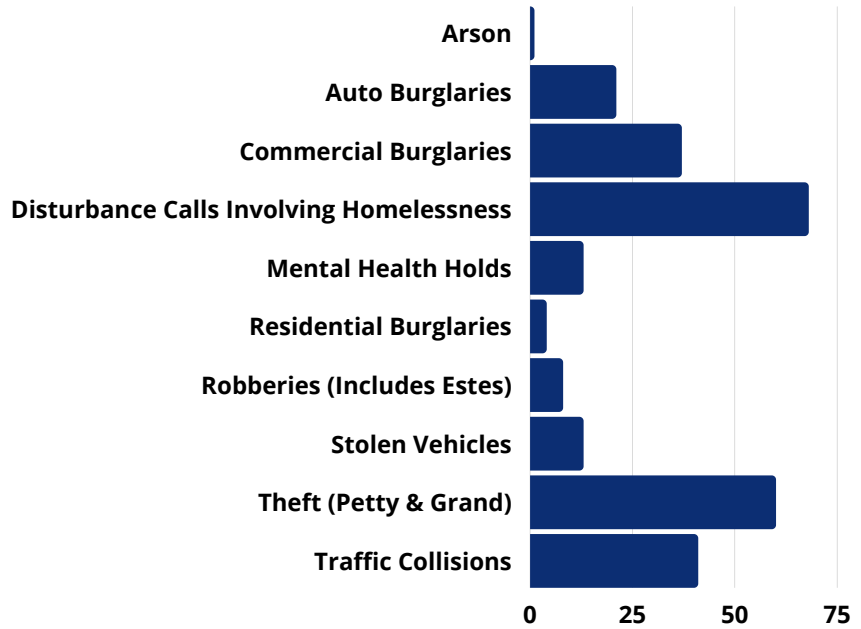


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 1/28 at approximately 7:00 p.m. an arson occurred at the Fremont Library, 2400 Stevenson Blvd. A witness observed a female suspect light items on fire and throw them into a dumpster. The fire spread and caused damage to a nearby conex box. The female suspect returned to the area and was identified. Jhamella Conley (39) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220128048

Auto Theft

On 1/27 at approximately 2:29 a.m. officers responded to a report of a stolen vehicle in the area of Sedum Rd. Approximately ten minutes later, officers located the vehicle in the area of Interstate 880 and Thornton Ave and conducted a high-risk vehicle stop. Battery

On 1/27 at approximately 11:39 a.m. a felony battery occurred in the parking lot of the Teen Center, 39770 Paseo Padre Pkwy. Victim was seated in his vehicle with the door open when a male suspect approached and began hitting the victim several times, causing injury. The suspect was located nearby and identified. The suspect was found to be on parole and was known to the victim. Edward Campbell (55) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220127013

Carjacking

On 1/26 at approximately 3:00 a.m. a carjacking occurred in the parking lot of Metro Fremont, 4444 Hansen Ave. Victims were ordered out of their vehicle at gunpoint by two male suspects and robbed of their personal belongings. The suspects then fled the scene with the victim's vehicle. #220126006

Commercial Burglary

On 1/27 at approximately 3:38 a.m. a commercial burglary occurred at a construction site, 37350 Sequoia Rd. A female suspect was seen on video surveillance attempting to gain access to an office building. Officers arrived on scene and located the female suspect. Quamela Hall (30) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220127005

Robbery

On 1/28 at approximately 4:25 p.m. a robbery occurred at the Ardenwood Plaza Shopping Center, 4900 Paseo Padre Pkwy. The victim made arrangements to sell shoes to a buyer via "Offer Up". After inspecting the items, the two male suspects grabbed the victim, threw him to the ground, and kicked him before fleeing the scene with the items. #220128038

Theft

On 1/28 at approximately 10:45 a.m. a jewelry theft occurred in the area of Coco Palm Dr. Victim was outside of her residence when a vehicle approached and a female suspect got out to ask the victim for directions. The female suspect grabbed the victim's arm and pulled her in as if she was going to hug her. As the suspect began to leave, the victim realized her jewelry was missing. #220130026
