

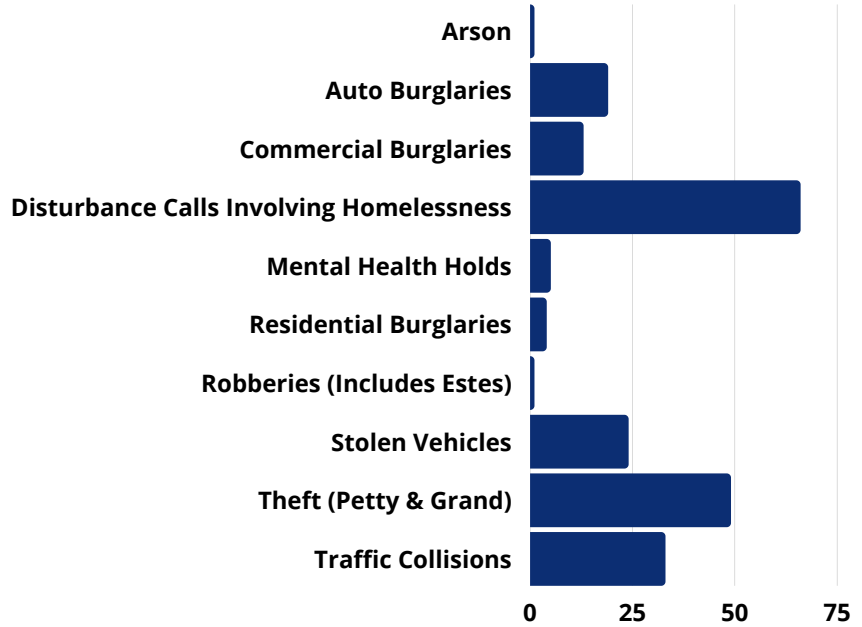


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Theft

On 5/23 at approximately 1:47 p.m. officers responded to a report of a stolen vehicle in the area of Kato Rd and Warren Ave. The theft had just occurred and the victim was actively tracking the vehicle's location. Officers responded to the area and observed a male suspect searching through the vehicle. A high-risk stop was conducted and the suspect was detained. Commercial Burglary

Between 5/16 and 5/17 a commercial burglary occurred at MRH Electronics, 41921 Osgood Rd. Suspect(s) used a rock to shatter a glass door and removed various electronics. #220517012

Warrant Service
