

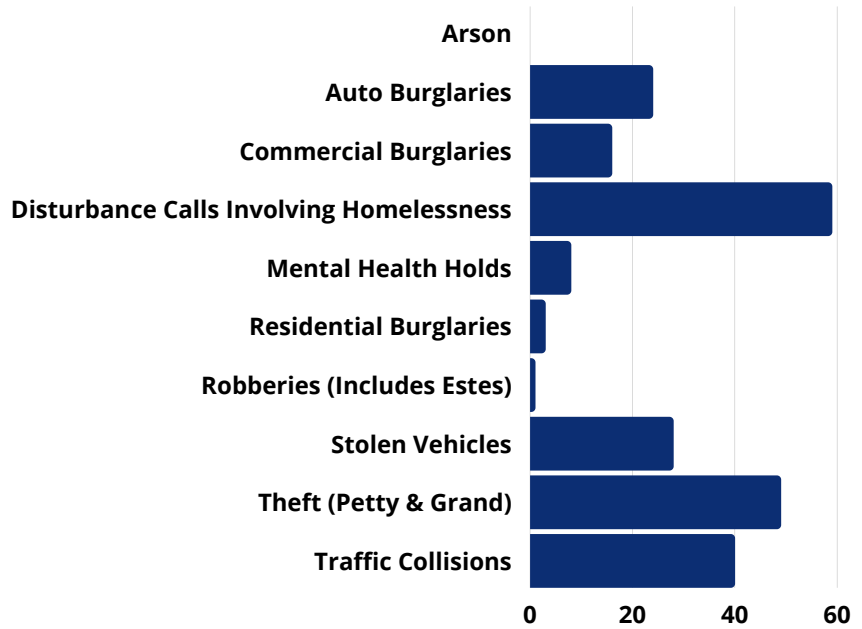


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Theft

On 5/30 at approximately 7:52 p.m. officers located an occupied stolen vehicle in the parking lot of Home Depot, 43900 Ice House Ter. Two suspects were detained and it was later determined to be a civil issue. However, one suspect was in possession of credit cards not in his name and the other had a misdemeanor warrant. Micha Meredith (55) out of Oakland and Lavonzy Pierson (52) out of Emeryville were both arrested. #220530030

On 5/30 at approximately 3:54 a.m. officers responded to a possible vehicle theft in the parking lot of the Estates at Park Place, 3400 Stevenson Blvd. Officers attempted to contact a male leaving the complex on a bicycle but he immediately fled. Officers located the male suspect a few blocks away and detained him. The male had two felony warrants, and was found to be in possession of burglary tools, and a controlled substance. On 5/30 at approximately 9:34 p.m. officers responded to a possible collision in the area of Peralta Blvd and Dusterberry Way. A witness advised there was a vehicle at rest on the center median. Firearm

On 5/29 at approximately 11:50 a.m. officers were dispatched to a disturbance outside of Grocery Outlet, 4949 Stevenson Blvd. A witness reported that a male suspect with a large sword was arguing with another male and it appeared to be escalating. Officers arrived and detained the suspect in the parking lot. A search of his persons and property revealed a machete, knife, loaded handgun, and a controlled substance. The suspect was found to be a convicted felon and the handgun was stolen. Vincent Wilson (33) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220529008

Robbery

On 5/28 at approximately 6:50 p.m. an armed robbery occurred in the area of Maple St. Victim witnessed two suspects stealing items from a neighbor's vehicle and tried to intervene. The suspects then pointed a handgun at the victim before fleeing in a vehicle. #220528031

Vandalism

On 5/29 at approximately 11:09 a.m. officers responded to a vandalism at the Marriot Hotel, 46100 Landing Pkwy. One of the floors at the hotel was currently under construction and a male that was not associated to the construction crew began breaking into rooms and causing damage. The male suspect was detained and found to be in possession of a controlled substance. Alfredo Bravo (38) out of Hayward was arrested. #220529009
