

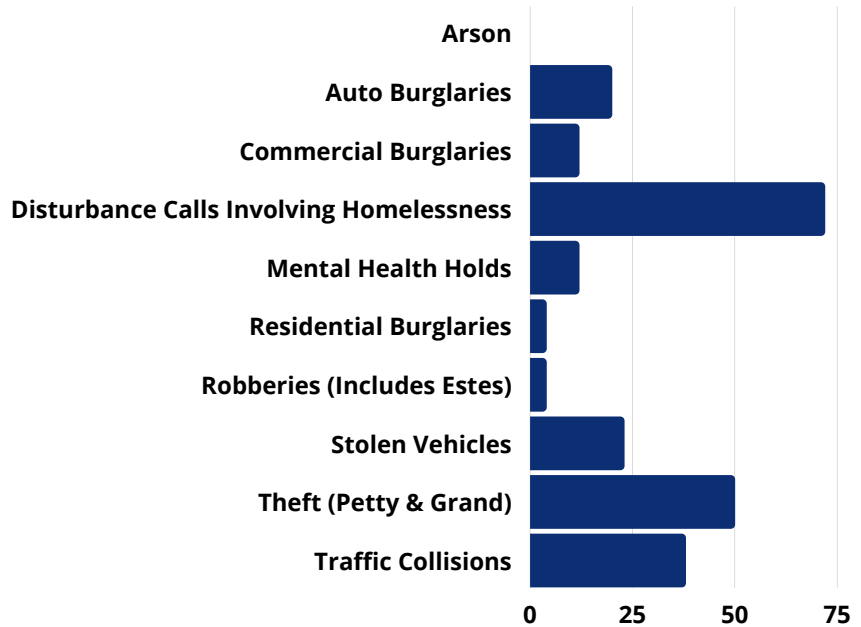


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Theft

On 6/12 at approximately 8:33 p.m. officers responded to a stolen vehicle at the Hyatt Place Hotel, 45976 Warm Springs Blvd. Victim was able to track their stolen vehicle to the aforementioned location using GPS. Officers located the vehicle in the parking lot and observed a male suspect in the front seat. Upon exiting the vehicle, the suspect immediately attempted to flee on foot but was quickly apprehended. The suspect was also found to be in possession of a controlled substance. Robert Robles (42) out of Fremont was arrested. #220612019

Driving Under the Influence

On 6/11 at approximately 7:55 p.m. officers responded to a possible drunk driver in the area of Grimmer Blvd and Doane St. Dispatch received multiple calls about a damaged vehicle driving around town that had possibly been involved in a collision. Victim called out to see who was there and discovered a rear sliding door and window had been opened. No suspects seen and no loss reported. #220612033

Robbery

On 6/12 at approximately 12:05 p.m. a robbery occurred at the Kwik and Convenient Market, 3157 Walnut Ave. A store clerk was physically assaulted by a male suspect after he was confronted about stealing. The clerk was able to get outside of the store and lock the suspect inside until officers arrived. Charles Sona (50) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220612022

On 6/12 at approximately 9:33 p.m. officers responded to a robbery at Ross, 4112 Fremont Hub. A male suspect took items from the store and brandished a knife as he fled. Vandalism

On 6/07 at approximately 4:43 p.m. officers responded to a vandalism of a vehicle in the area of Washington Hospital, 2000 Mowry Ave. A male suspect had been escorted out of the hospital for causing a disturbance and proceeded to break a side mirror off of a vehicle in the parking lot. Officers located the male nearby and detained him. Ethan Willoughby (29) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220607034

On 6/13 at approximately 4:17 a.m. a felony vandalism occurred in the 39000 block of Fremont Blvd. A male suspect used a shopping cart to shatter the windows of several businesses in the area.
