

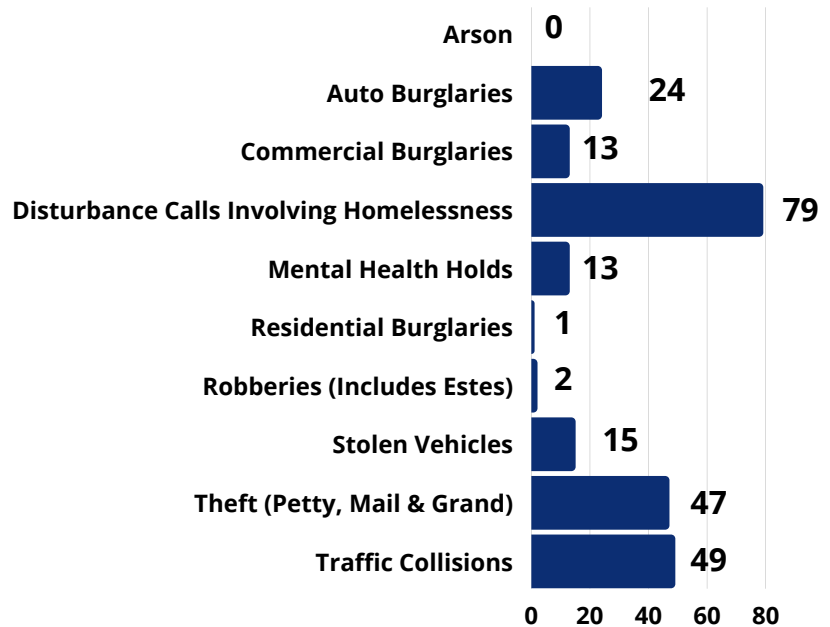


Fremont Police Week In Review

Felony Hit and Run

On 08/28, officers responded to a report of a motorist driving recklessly in the area of Thornton Ave and Balboa Way, resulting in a collision involving five other vehicles. The suspect driver and his passenger fled on foot after the crash. Upon arrival, officers triaged the crash site and set a perimeter. Within 30 minutes, officers were able to locate the driver and the passenger. One adult suspect out of Fremont and one adult suspect out of Union City were medically cleared and arrested. #220828026

Possession of Narcotics

On 08/25, officers conducted an enforcement stop on Fremont Blvd on a pedestrian (suspect) who was jaywalking. The suspect was found to be on active probation out of a nearby county and was in possession of narcotics. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220825018

On 08/26, officers responded to a suspicious person (suspect) walking and standing her the reporting party's vehicle on a private residential driveway on D Street. Officers arrived and located the suspect who was found to be in possession of a controlled substance. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220826002

Public Intoxication

On 08/24, officers responded to a call from a fast-food restaurant in Centerville. Restaurant employees reported two suspects yelling, hitting the doors, and causing a disturbance. Upon arrival, officers located both suspects and both were determined to be intoxicated. One adult suspect out of Fremont and one adult suspect out of Union City were arrested. #220825003

Shots Fired

On 08/26, officers responded to a reported shooting at a bar located on Niles Blvd. Witnesses stated that an argument occurred between two groups inside the bar. One suspect, who had an unknown association to the groups, came from outside the bar and fired several rounds from a handgun into the front overhang of the building. No one was struck by the gunfire and the suspect quickly fled in a vehicle. This case remains under active investigation. #220827002

Stolen Property

On 08/26, officers spotted an individual (suspect) acting suspiciously and pushing a motorcycle down the sidewalk on South Grimmer Blvd. They contacted the suspect and determined the motorcycle was stolen. One adult suspect out of Hayward was arrested. #220826012

Stolen Vehicle Recovery

On 08/27, officers were dispatched to a suspicious vehicle parked in the driveway of a business near High and Union Street. After conducting a registration check, officers learned that the plates on the vehicle did not match the registration. The vehicle was listed as stolen out of a nearby city. The driver (suspect) was in the vehicle and contacted. The suspect was initially uncooperative. After about 25 minutes of negotiations the suspect stepped out of the vehicle. One adult suspect out of Oakland was arrested and the vehicle was towed. #220827010
