

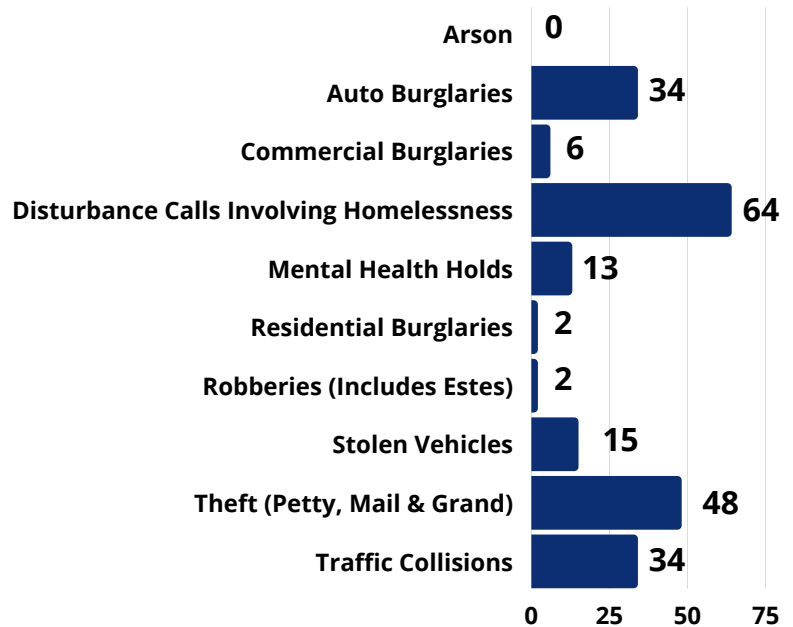


Fremont Police Week In Review

Battery

On 9/2, officers responded to an apartment on Bell St after the reporting party advised that his mother's boyfriend had battered them. Officers contacted the reporting party and his mother outside the apartment and learned that the suspect had locked himself inside the apartment. Officers eventually got a hold of the suspect on the phone and persuaded him to come out. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220902030

Battery (Sexual)

On 8/30, officers responded to an apartment complex on Paseo Padre Pkwy regarding a suspect who had followed the victim home on foot from a nearby grocery store. During the walk, the suspect approached and touched the victim inappropriately. The suspect continued to follow the victim as the victim entered a friend's apartment. Once inside, the friend learned of the incident, chased the suspect from the apartment, and contacted the police. Officers quickly arrived and located the suspect. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220831001

Domestic Violence

On 8/30, officers responded to a domestic violence report on Old Canyon Rd, where the suspect threw an air conditioning unit at the spouse (victim). The suspect was on probation and had a pending restraining order that needed to be served. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220830032

Indecent Exposure

On 9/5, officers responded to a report of an indecent exposure on Roberts Ave where a male (suspect) exposed himself to a female (victim), followed her down the street, and then left the area. The victim was able to provide a suspect description. A few hours later, officers located the suspect. An infield lineup was conducted, and the suspect was positively identified. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220905031

Person Down

On 9/4, officers responded to a call of a person climbing onto a traffic signal pole near the intersection of Central Ave and Blacow Rd. While driving by, the reporting party heard the subject yelling while climbing the pole. The reporting party decided to make a U-turn to return to the intersection to check on the subject. Upon arrival, the reporting party saw that the subject had fallen and was lying on the ground. Officers and Fremont Fire Department arrived on the scene, and the subject was pronounced deceased. This case remains under investigation. #220904002

Stolen Vehicle Recovery/Evading Police

On 9/1, officers spotted a stolen vehicle near Stevenson Blvd and Besco Rd and initiated a traffic stop. The vehicle failed to yield and fled the area. A short time later, a homeowner called and advised the vehicle was illegally parked in their driveway. The homeowner was able to provide a description of the suspect driving the vehicle. Officers located the suspect driver and towed the vehicle. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220901024

Warrant Arrest

On 8/30, officers responded to a possible in-progress residential burglary on Vanda Way. Upon arrival, officers located the suspect and discovered the suspect was related to the homeowner and had permission to be there. The suspect, however, had multiple outstanding misdemeanor warrants. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220830007
