

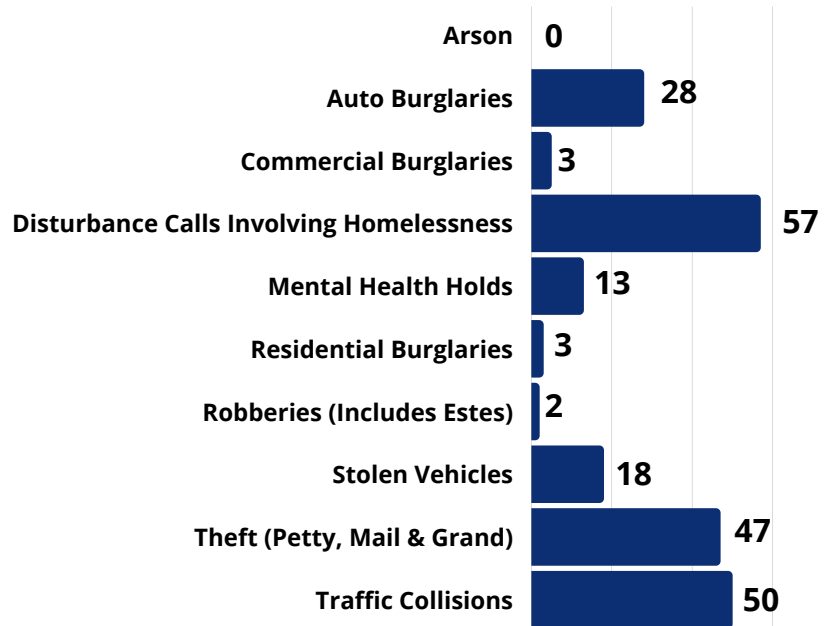


Fremont Police Week In Review

Catalytic Converter Theft

On 12/7, a victim contacted dispatch and advised that he had just interrupted two subjects as they were attempting to steal the catalytic converter from his vehicle. As he was grabbing the suspect under his vehicle, the suspect removed a silver revolver and shot one round in his direction. The two subjects then ran to a vehicle and fled. This case remains under investigation. #221207005

Mail Theft

On 12/9, officers responded to a mail theft on Amiens Ave. A witness saw the theft taking place and obtained the suspect vehicle's license plate number. Officers located the suspect vehicle in the area of Fremont Blvd and Sundale Dr, and the driver was taken into custody. A search of the vehicle resulted in the recovery of stolen mail, a mailbox master key, and a methamphetamine pipe. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221209005

Reported Shooting

On 12/6, officers responded to a reported shooting on Baine Ave. The victim advised the driver of a gold minivan shot at their vehicle three to four times. The occupants were not injured, and the vehicle had damage consistent with bullet impacts to the lower corner of the driver-side door. After canvassing the area, officers found a bullet fragment in the roadway but no shell casings. Initial investigation suggested this was not a random event. This case remains under investigation. #221206033

Robbery

On 12/7, officers were dispatched to a hotel on Farwell Place regarding a suspicious person (suspect) associated with a parked vehicle near the front lobby. Officers located the vehicle and learned it was a victim vehicle from a carjacking in a nearby city. Officers received additional information that the suspect committed a robbery inside the hotel and at another nearby location. Officers located the suspect in a nearby parking lot and detained him without incident. One adult suspect out of Oakland was arrested. #221207034

Return of Stolen Property

On 12/8, officers were dispatched to the 5400 block of Mowry Ave for a victim of an auto burglary from another city who was tracking her stolen items. Officers arrived and found several backpacks that had been stolen from nearby cities. Officers were able to make contact with most victims and return their property. #221208027

Other Arrests:

On 12/6, officers responded to a violation of a court order on Purcell Place. The suspect knocked on his ex-wife's front door and looked into her windows. The suspect was subsequently arrested for violating the court order and possessing a controlled substance. #221206032

On 12/8, Officers responded to a hit-and-run vehicle collision that occurred in the area of Mowry Ave and Blacow Rd. The victim followed the suspect's vehicle and directed incoming officers who contacted the suspect. Officers determined that the suspect was driving under the influence and was responsible for the hit-and-run. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221208032

On 12/9, officers responded to a report of a vehicle that crashed into a house. The driver was contacted on scene and found to be highly intoxicated. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested for DUI. #221209046
