

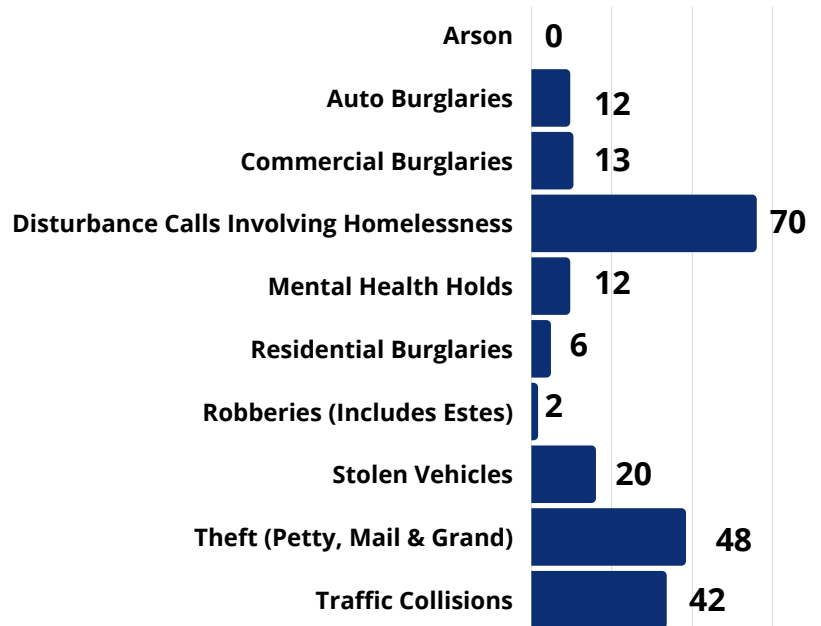


Fremont Police Week In Review

Carjacking

On 12/13, officers responded to a carjacking at a grocery store on Stevenson Blvd where an elderly victim was walking to her vehicle when she was attacked from behind. The victim fell to the ground and sustained a head injury. The suspect took the victim's keys and fled in her vehicle. Officers canvas neighboring businesses and learn the suspect was in the store earlier in the day and may have been responsible for a commercial burglary several weeks ago. The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment. The case remains under active investigation. #221213010

On 12/18, officers responded to a carjacking at a store on Stevenson Blvd near Blacow Rd. A suspect accosted a female victim in the parking lot before stealing her passenger vehicle. Officers located the vehicle and initiated a pursuit. The suspect vehicle collided with an uninvolved vehicle on the freeway near I-680 and Landess Ave in Milpitas. One of the occupants of that victim's vehicle was ejected on impact and suffered significant injuries. He was transported to a local trauma center for treatment. Three suspects were contacted in the carjacked vehicle and were taken into custody. The case remains under active investigation. #221218021

Fight

On 12/17, officers responded to a report of a large fight at the parking lot of a bar located on Peralta Blvd. When officers arrived on the scene, the parking lot was mostly cleared out, and no victims, or suspects, were located. Officers made their way into the bar and contacted a subject refusing to leave per the request of the staff. Investigation revealed that the fight did occur, and the subject was involved. One adult suspect out of Union City was arrested. #221217003

Robbery

On 12/17, officers responded to a robbery involving multiple suspects at a convenience store located on Mojave Dr. Officers arrived quickly, however, the suspects had already fled the area. FPD was notified that

a nearby city had a robbery at a convenience store that involved similar suspects earlier in the evening. Shortly after, FPD was also informed that a similar robbery had occurred in another nearby city. Officers conducted security checks in several convenience stores in Fremont after the incident. This case remains under active investigation. #221217025

Other Arrests

On 12/13, officers responded to a robbery on Carol Ave where a subject approached three students with a weapon demanding property. Officers located the suspect near the Irvington High School campus. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221213006

On 12/14, FPD teamed up with the FBI and led a team of detectives and patrol officers on a warrant service on Japala Ct to locate and arrest a suspect regarding a fraud investigation. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #211214026

On 12/15, officers were dispatched to Vallejo Mills Park to ascertain a problem involving a female yelling on the phone. The victim was assaulted by her boyfriend, who struck her in the head with his cane. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221215036

On 12/16, officers were patrolling the area of Thornton/Cabrillo when they came across a stolen vehicle. A car stop was initiated on the vehicle, and an adult suspect out of San Leandro was arrested. #221216012
