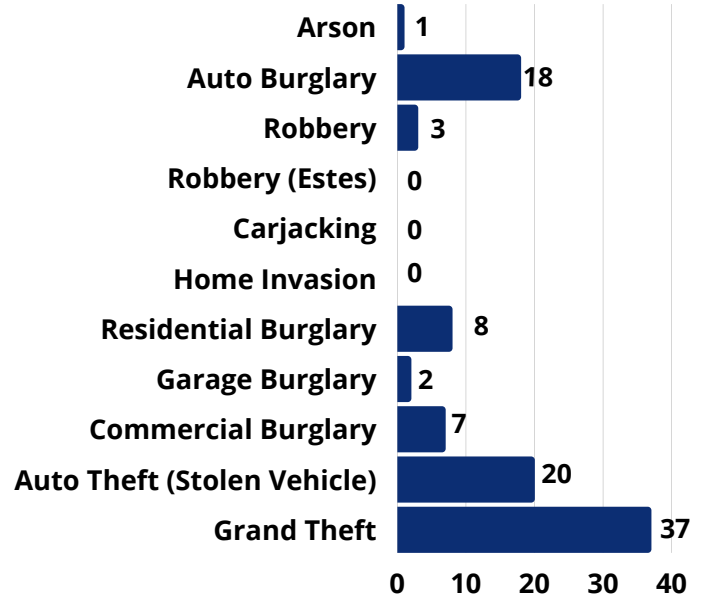




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Ascertain the problem

On 3/17, dispatch received calls from an individual on Gralina Terrance, advising that he wanted to hurt himself and his neighbors. The subject reported that he had a shotgun in the house. Several units, including our Mobile Evaluation Team (MET), Hostage Negotiation Team (HNT), and UAV (drone) team, responded and formulated a plan to contact the subject. During the contact, the subject made several "suicide by cop" statements. Officers utilized the armored vehicle to approach him safely. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was safely detained and transported to a local hospital for a mental health evaluation. #230317027

## Arson

On 3/18, officers patrolling the area of Thornton Ave and I-880 noticed smoke coming from a grassy area on the side of the roadway. Officers observed a subject that appeared to start a small grass fire and attempted to stop him. Assisting officers arrived and detained the subject without incident while first responders extinguished the fire. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230318005

## Brandishing a Weapon

On 3/15, a local medical center staff called to report that a subject had brandished a firearm in their emergency room. The medical center staff was able to secure the firearm, which was a replica BB gun. Officers arrived and contacted the subject. Further investigation reveals that the subject had multiple warrants for his arrest. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230315004

## Outside Assist

On 3/16, a vehicle stolen from a nearby City was traveling northbound on Fremont Blvd. Officers located the vehicle and followed it until it stopped at a local church. Two subjects exited the vehicle and fled on foot. Officers detained one subject and broadcasted the description of the second subject. Additional officers arrived and located the second subject in the middle of the church complex. Both subjects were arrested, one out of Fremont and one out of East Palo Alto. #230316002

## Possession of a Stolen Vehicle

On 3/15, officers spotted a stolen vehicle on I-880 as it was approaching Thornton Ave. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle, but it fled. Officers did not pursue the suspect vehicle but watched as it took the Thornton Ave exit. The subject lost control of the vehicle and crashed into the guardrail at the freeway exit. The subject, an adult out of Newark, was arrested. #230315014

## Residential Burglary

On 3/15, a resident called dispatch to report an in-progress residential burglary on Blue Fin Way. A worker heard a rear window shatter and believed a subject was inside the home. Units quickly arrived and set up containment. A search team cleared the house and did not locate the subject. This case remains under investigation. #230316001

## Robbery

On 3/17, officers responded to a robbery at a convenience store on Mowry Ave. Two subjects were in the store taking items while a third subject stood to watch at the door. As officers responded, the subjects fled westbound on Mowry. Officers conducted security checks at other convenience stores throughout the city, and an alert went out to neighboring agencies. This case remains under investigation. #230317002

## Vehicle Collision

On 3/18, officers responded to a residence on Belvedere Ter to a report of a vehicle that had crashed into the side of a home. Upon arrival, officers learned that a juvenile was driving his parents' car, collided with a parked vehicle, and ultimately stopped when the car crashed into a home. The juvenile subject was cited and released to his parents. #230318002

## Warrant Service/Possession of Stolen Motorcycle

On 3/16, officers checked a residence on Fremont Blvd, where a well-known adult subject is known to squat. Officers observed the subject riding on a stolen motorcycle the day prior. Officers, including the K-9 unit, set up a perimeter at the residence. The subject exited the residence and attempted to flee. Due to the perimeter, the subject surrendered and was arrested without incident. #230316011
