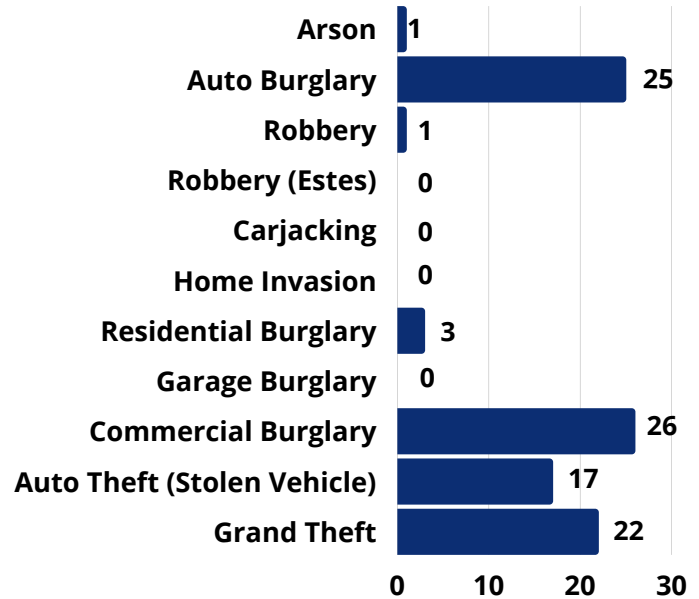

Arson

On 4/18, officers responded to the area of Thornton Ave and Dondero Way to a report of a vehicle fire. Upon arrival, officers located a vehicle fully engulfed, and the vehicle was reported stolen from a nearby city. This case remains under investigation. #230418043

Ascertain a Problem/Robbery

On 4/20, officers responded to a robbery at a liquor store's parking lot on Walnut Ave. A subject attempted to rob a family of the alcohol they had just purchased from the store. The family was able to drive away without any loss. The subject then approached another subject who was in the process of consuming a bottle of alcohol. A fight ensued between the two subjects as officers arrived on the scene. Upon arrival, officers detained both subjects. One adult subject out of Sacramento was arrested. #23420024

Brandishing a Firearm

On 4/19, officers responded to reports of a firearm sighting on Parkside Dr and Eggers Dr. Several reporting parties indicated a vehicle in the area was brandishing a firearm. Officers immediately arrived but could not locate the suspect vehicle or any victims. This case remains under investigation. #230419033

Family Disturbance/Criminal Threats

On 4/20, officers responded to a family disturbance on Laurel St. The reporting party's brother (subject) threatened to hurt their father. Officers met with the family and located the subject. One adult subject out of Fremont was arrested. #230420001

Grand Theft

On 4/20, officers responded to a grand theft at a retail store at Pacific Commons. A subject ran out with a cart full of merchandise and got into a waiting vehicle. Officers caught up to the vehicle on Northbound 880, and the vehicle yielded. The driver and the vehicle's passenger both had outstanding warrants. Two adult subjects were arrested, one out of Fremont and one out of Hayward. #230420023

Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 4/21, officers responded to the area of Ice House Tr to a subject exposing herself to passing vehicles. Officers arrived and conducted a welfare check; however, the subject refused to receive help. As officers were clearing the scene, the subject began requesting help. Ultimately, the subject, an adult out of Fremont, was placed under a mental health evaluation hold. #230421006

On 4/23, officers responded to a report of a high school student wanting to self-harm in the area near Ohlone College. The student got into a family argument and was sitting on the edge of the roof of a building. Multiple units arrived and began negotiations with the student. The student ultimately came down from the edge and was placed on a mental health evaluation hold. #230423017

Under the Influence of Controlled Substance

On 4/18, officers responded to a local hospital to the report of a subject seeking assistance from being chased. However, the hospital staff did not see anyone chasing the subject. Officers arrived and contacted the subject, who was determined to be under the influence of a controlled substance. One adult subject out of Fremont was arrested. #230418001

Vandalism/Possession of a Firearm

On 4/23, officers responded to the area near Fremont Hub for the report of a firearm being seen in possession by three subjects. The reporting party challenged the subjects as they were spray-painting graffiti near a restaurant. One of the subjects displayed a firearm, while another subject claimed to have another firearm in possession. Officers immediately arrived, located all three subjects, and recovered a firearm. Officers determined two subjects to be juveniles and gave them notices to appear in court. The third subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230423023
