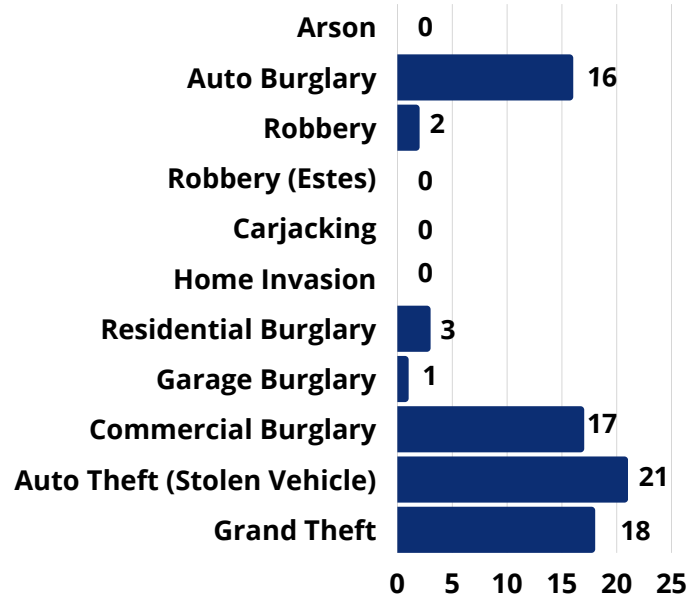

Assault with a Deadly Weapon/Shots Fired

On 5/3, Officers responded to the area of Paseo Pkwy and Ardenwood Bl regarding a shooting that had just occurred. The reporting party (victim) advised that a subject from another vehicle shot a gun at her vehicle and busted the window, and fled the scene. Once units arrived, they found the victim was not injured, and the incident possibly stemmed from road rage between the subject and the victim. The victim's vehicle sustained several bullet holes from the gunfire. This case remains under investigation. #230503031

Brandishing a Weapon

On 5/5, officers responded to a business in Irvington after a victim reported seeing a subject brandishing a gun. The victim reported that he got into an argument with the subject, and the subject produced a small silver pistol from his pocket. Officers arrived, checked the area, and contacted several individuals but could not locate anyone matching the description provided. This case remains under investigation. #230505029

Grand Theft/Resisting Arrest

On 5/2, officers patrolling the Pacific Commons Shopping Center received notification of a theft that had just occurred. Officers arrived on the scene and located the subject. After a brief struggle, the subject was arrested. The subject, an adult out of San Francisco, was medically cleared before being transported to Santa Rita Jail. #230502045

Mental Health Evaluation Hold/Possession of Narcotics

On 5/4, officers responded to the report of a subject acting erratically at an apartment complex on High St. The subject rambled about hearing voices and being watched. The reporting party advised that the subject has a history of mental health issues and saw the subject hitting the walls with a golf club and stabbing the walls with a knife. The subject barricaded herself and her child in the apartment and was streaming live on social media. Upon arrival, officers negotiated with the subject for an extended period before entering the apartment. Officers safely contacted and detained the subject, and the child was unharmed. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was provided medical care at the scene and placed on a mental health evaluation hold. #230504014

Possession of a Firearm and Marijuana

On 5/3, officers responded to a local high school to investigate a report of a vehicle parked in the staff parking lot that emanated a strong odor of marijuana. Officers observed the strong odor as they approached the vehicle. Officers also observed multiple packages of marijuana in the vehicle. The driver, a juvenile subject, was contacted, and a vehicle search revealed a firearm, a stun gun, and a large amount of marijuana. The subject, a juvenile out of Fremont, was arrested and released with a Notice to Appear in Court. #230503005

Robbery

On 5/6, officers responded to a local motel on Farwell Place regarding an armed robbery. The victim advised that the subject pointed a firearm at him and demanded his property. The victim was at a large party when the robbery occurred and believed the subject was still at the motel. Officers investigated and identified an associated room. Officers conducted a call-out and temporarily detained several subjects from the room. The victim did not positively identify anyone as the subject responsible for the robbery. Officers authored a search warrant for the room but found no evidence of the crime. #230506001

Robbery/Catalytic Converter Theft

On 5/7, officers responded to a report of a catalytic converter theft attempt on Onondaga Dr. Three unknown subjects attempted to steal the victim's catalytic converter from his vehicle in the driveway. The victim confronted the subjects in front of his home. One of the subjects, who was acting as a lookout, pointed a handgun at the victim, who then retreated into his home while the subjects fled. This case remains under investigation. #230507004

Stolen Vehicle Recovery

On 5/8, officers responded to a vehicle theft at a grocery store on Las Palmas Ave that had just occurred. The victim left his keys and wallet in his vehicle when he went inside the store for a few minutes – he returned to find his vehicle gone. Shortly after that, officers received community camera notifications regarding the vehicle's location. Officers recovered the vehicle in the Auto Mall area and returned the vehicle to the victim. #230508022

Trespassing and Resisting Arrest

On 5/8, officers responded to a local manufacturing company for a report of an employee fighting with security. The subject allegedly possessed a controlled substance and fought with security when they investigated. Security asked the subject to leave, and he refused. Upon arrival, officers advised the subject that he was trespassing and would be arrested if he remained on the property. The subject, an adult out of South San Francisco, refused to leave and was arrested. #230508016
