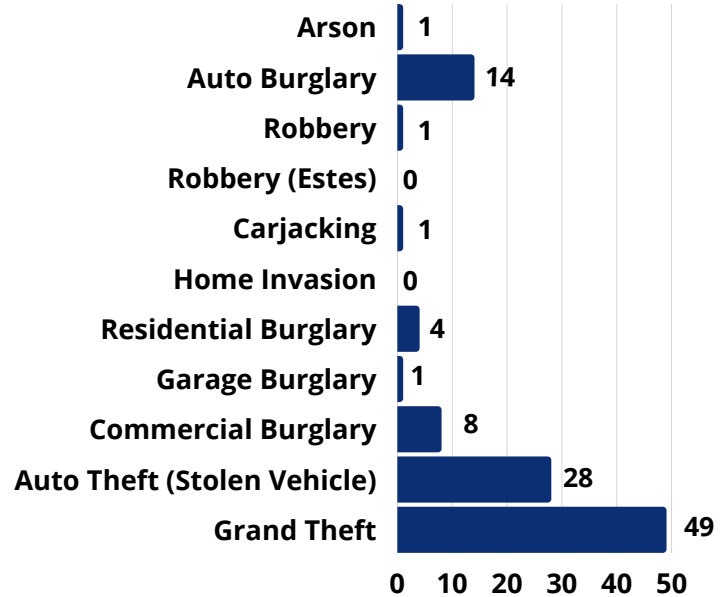

Arson

On 5/19, officers responded to a fire at a car dealership on Auto Mall Pkwy. An employee heard loud explosions from the parking lot and noticed four vehicles engulfed in flames. Surveillance captured a male subject leaving the area on foot. Fremont Fire safely extinguished the fire. This case remains under investigation. #230519001

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 5/18, dispatch received a call regarding a battery in front of a grocery store on Argonaut Way. A male subject struck a female victim in the back of the head. During the call, police personnel determined that the assault occurred an hour before they contacted the police. The female victim was likely walking past a fight between two male subjects. As she passed them, she was the unintended victim as one of the males swung a metal water bottle. The victim's husband transported her to an area hospital for treatment. This case remains under investigation. #230518042

On 5/22, officers responded to a local motel on Farwell Dr to the report of a subject brandishing a knife. Officers investigated and learned that the subject attempted to stab a family member with a knife during an argument. The subject, an adult out of Newark, was arrested. #230522023

Carjacking

On 5/19, officers responded to a carjacking at a local wholesale business at Pacific Commons. Two subjects armed with firearms confronted the driver (victim) and three occupants in the parking lot. The subjects pistol-whipped the driver and another passenger before taking possession of the victim's vehicle. The victims were not seriously injured and did not require medical care. This case remains under investigation. #230519045

Commercial Burglary

On 5/19, officers responded to an in-progress burglary at a preschool on Warm Springs Blvd. The reporting party received an alert via video surveillance that a subject was inside the school office. Officers arrived and set up a containment. Officers searched the school and determined that the subject had fled the area before officers' arrival. This case remains under investigation. #230519002

Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 5/22, officers patrolling the Fremont Blvd and Sundale Dr area noticed an individual who appeared to be experiencing a mental health crisis. The subject ran into oncoming traffic and began yelling threats and obscenities at random people. The subject fled on foot and accessed a nearby business through the rear emergency exit, where officers detained him. The adult subject was placed on a mental health evaluation hold and transported to a local hospital. #230522032

Robbery

On 5/16, officers responded to a grocery store on Mowry Ave after two subjects attempted to exit the store with a cartload of alcohol. The subjects rammed a store employee (victim) with the cart, causing minor injury to the employee's knee. The subjects made their way to a waiting vehicle in the parking lot and fled. This case remains under investigation. #230516042

Stolen Vehicle

On 5/18, a caller reported that he had his vehicle stolen in San Jose and followed it into Fremont. Officers responded to the area and located the stolen vehicle in a parking lot off Washington Blvd. The driver of the stolen vehicle, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested without incident. #230518021

On 5/22, community cameras alerted officers to a stolen vehicle near Osgood Rd and Grimmer Blvd. Officers arrived in the area, located the vehicle, and attempted to conduct an enforcement stop. The vehicle fled, and no pursuit was initiated. However, the subject's vehicle collided with a center median shortly after. Officers saw three subjects running in separate directions. After an area search, officers located an adult subject and two juvenile subjects. The adult subject, out of Fremont, admitted to being the driver of the stolen vehicle and was arrested. Officers released one juvenile to his parent and transported another juvenile to an assessment center. #230522030

Suspicious Circumstances

On 5/17, officers responded to Stewart Ave and Albrae St. to a report of a trailer engulfed in flames. The intensity of the fire also caused a power pole and a grounding wire to ignite. Officers arrived and diverted traffic, and Fremont Fire safely extinguished the trailer. Collaborative investigative efforts deemed the fire as suspicious circumstances. This case remains under investigation. #230517027
